- Speak/Share (*Oratio*): Prayerfully share with Jesus or with the group your thoughts and feelings.
- Rest in God's presence (*Contemplatio*): Notice God's presence and be still, surrounded by God's love.
- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God's nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

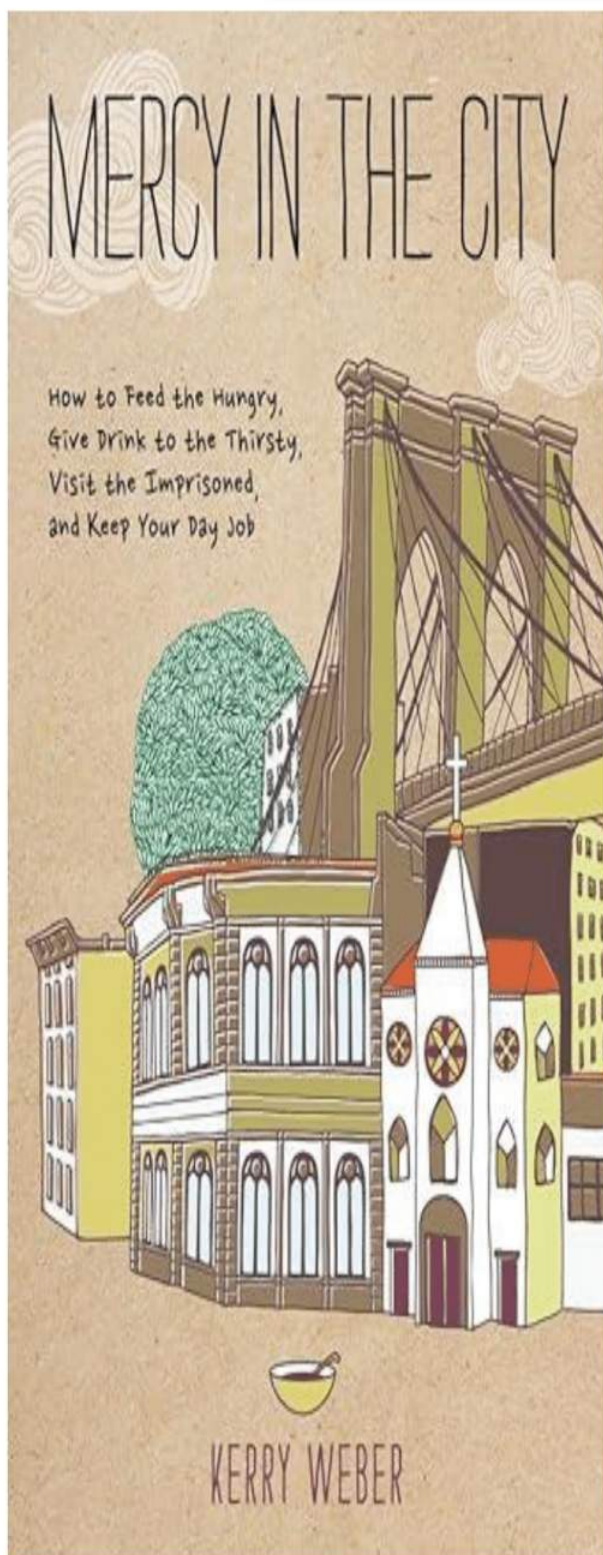


Our next meeting is on Wednesday, January 21 at 7:00 PM in the Ministry Center Conference Room (in the church, down the hallway past the restrooms).

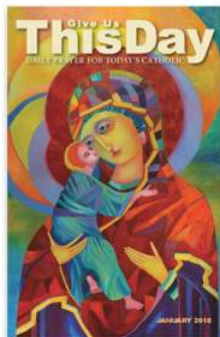

Our parish subscription to the daily devotional book Give Us This Day will expire in March.

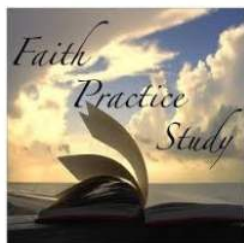

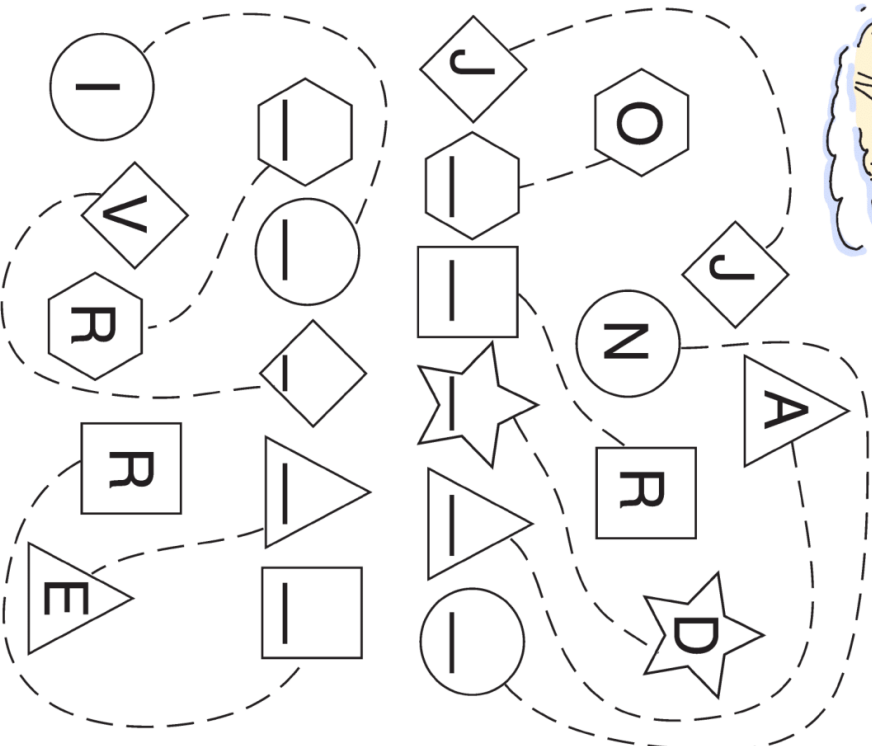


Which river was Jesus baptized in?
