The Word

Reading for March 22, 2026

John 11:3-7, 17, 20-27, 33b-45

Adults:

The death from which we are called is healing from those things which bind us and hold us back: memories, fears, rejection, or other such things. What binds you? What keeps you from fully being your own most true self in Christ?

We offer this form of *Lectio Divina* (sacred reading) for pondering Scripture and for faith sharing with family members and other people.

- Listen/ Read (*Lectio*): Ponder God's word and listen for what touches your heart.
- Meditate (*Meditatio*): Attend to what you notice. Allow God's word to resonate in you.
- Speak/Share (*Oratio*): Prayerfully share with Jesus or with the group your thoughts and feelings.
- Rest in God's presence (*Contemplatio*): Notice God's presence and be still, surrounded by God's love.
- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God's nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

Children:

How do your actions show that you put your faith and trust in Jesus?

VBS - Snowball Mountain Challenge



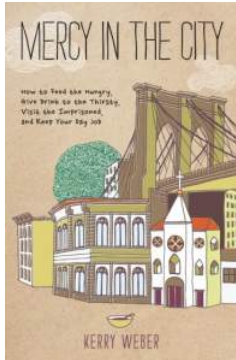

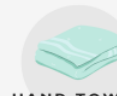

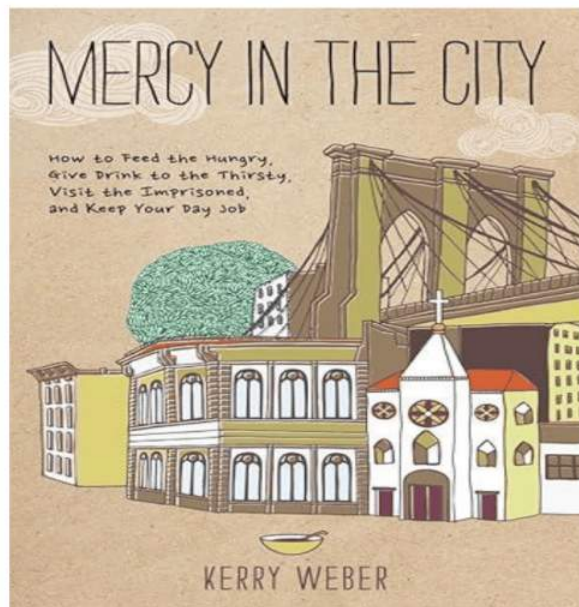

Catholic Relief Services - Embracing God's Love : Lesson from Stories of Hope



In the book of Genesis, we learn that God created man and woman in his image, reminding us that every person is sacred and reflects the God's love. Each of us has a purpose, woven into God's plan. As children of God, all people deserve respect and care—especially those who are most vulnerable.

When we reflect on the challenges faced by our sisters and brothers in Ghana, Guatemala and Timor-Leste, we see how their resilience and courage helped them overcome adversity. Their stories remind us to treat every person with dignity and compassion.

In Ghana, Georgina lives in a rural area where poverty makes it difficult for families to get health and nutrition services for their children to grow healthy and strong. When a clinic opened to help mothers and children, it helped kids reach important milestones. Georgina's children are now learning their ABCs and counting. She uses her knowledge at home and shares it with others. Thanks to this support, children in Walewae have a brighter future.

In Guatemala, Maribel and her family didn't eat healthily and felt unwell. After learning about the importance of nutritious foods in a CRS program, her family began adding fruits, vegetables, protein and vitamins into their daily routine. Now their health is improving.

In Timor-Leste, malnutrition is common among young girls because families have limited access to nutritious food. That makes it even more important for them to learn about nutrition and self-care. Through CRS nutrition classes, Adriana learned how iron prevents conditions like anemia and how protein and carbohydrates help her brain grow.

As we continue our Lenten journey, let us reflect on these Stories of Hope and consider where we fit into their broader story. ***Do we see the face of Christ in others? What keeps us from recognizing others as God's children? How can we respond with love?***

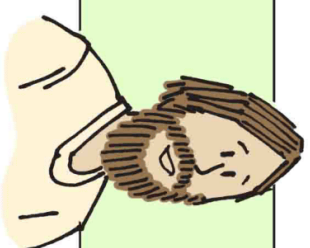
