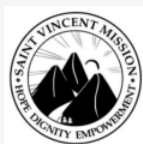

Highlights from Dr. Lisa Cerceo's "Care for Creation" Presentation on April 15, 2026

"After the presentation, we had an outside choir rehearsal held in the area next to the parking lot. As we began to sing we were accompanied by groups of birds flying overhead just chirping and singing along with us. By the time we got to our second song, two geese landed in the parking lot near us and also joined in. They were a little flat, but we appreciated hearing their voices. It was a testament that we are all God's creatures joining together to sing praises to our Creator."

"Care for creation is not separate from our faith—it is one of the clearest ways we live it."

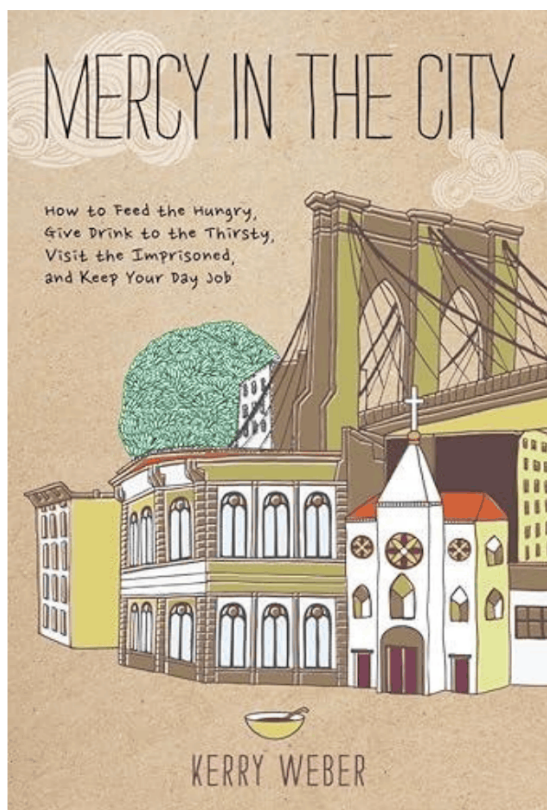
- Faith, science, and care for creation are deeply connected. Dr. Elizabeth Lisa Cerceo, Professor of Medicine and Executive Director of Climate Health at Cooper Medical School of Rowan University, framed climate and planetary health as a spiritual, ethical, and scientific call, rooted in Scripture and Catholic social teaching, especially *Laudato Si'* and the new exhortation *Dilexi Te*.
- "You cannot have healthy people on a sick planet." The talk showed how air pollution, rising temperatures, climate-intensified disasters, plastics, and endocrine-disrupting chemicals are already harming health "from womb to tomb," increasing risks of asthma, cardiovascular disease, cancer, adverse pregnancy outcomes, and mental health challenges.
- A "true ecological approach is always a social approach." Echoing Pope Francis, the presentation emphasized that climate change and environmental degradation trap people in poverty, hit children and elders especially hard, and magnify long-standing racial and economic inequities.
- Nature as medicine and sacrament. Participants learned about forest therapy / nature prescription programs and the growing science on how time in green spaces can reduce stress, improve cardiovascular and immune function, and strengthen social connection, reinforcing spiritual traditions that see nature as a place where God speaks to us.
- From awareness to action and hope. Rather than doom, the session focused on Christian hope and concrete responses: reducing personal and parish pollution, supporting policies that protect clean air and a stable climate, engaging in environmental justice, planting trees, electrifying where possible, and "making a ruckus" for our neighbors today and for future generations.

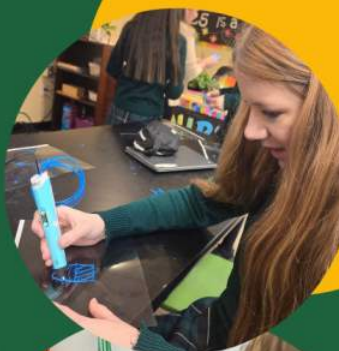

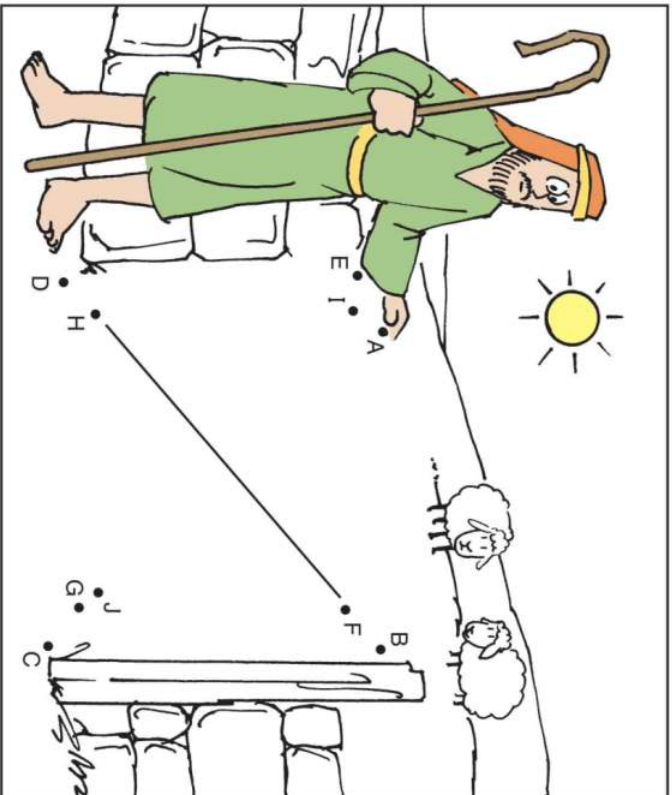

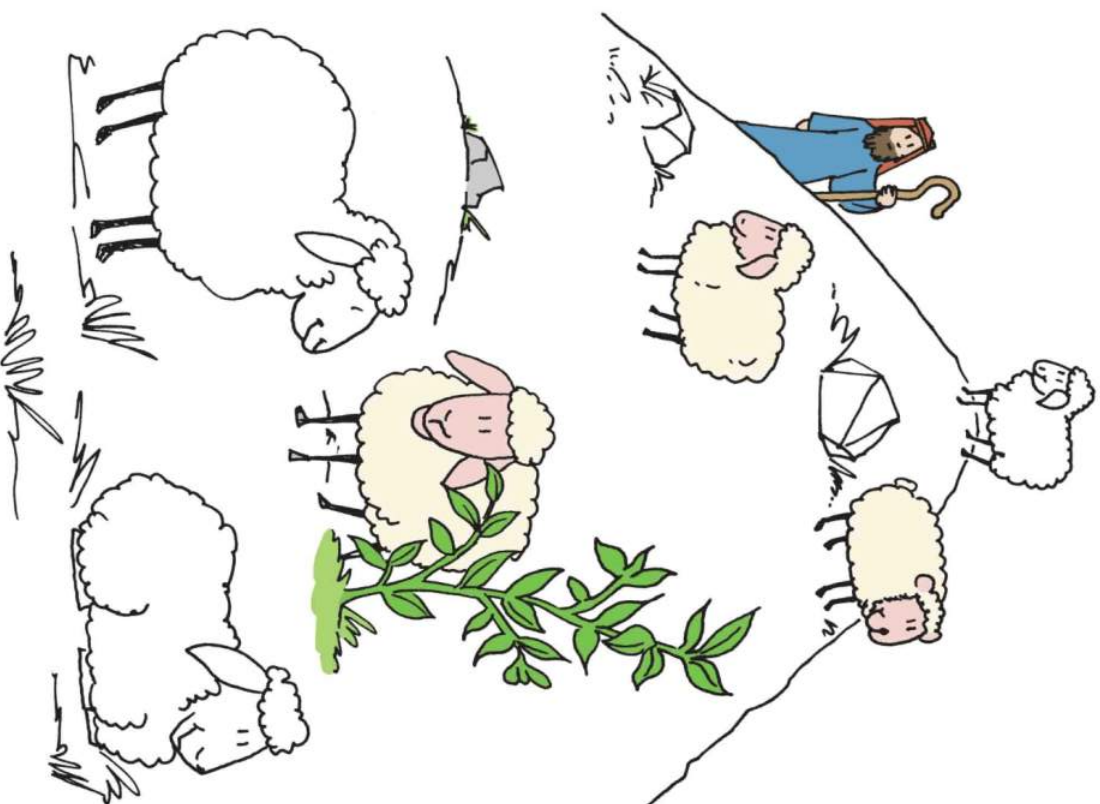
