A festival of the light of Christ is a way of celebrating the resurrection which, for each person, already begins invisibly here on earth. Upon entering the church, which should be dimly lit, everyone receives a small candle. While a song of resurrection is sung, each person's candle is lit, until the whole church is full of light. This is a sign of the light of Christ, which also symbolizes our identity as Christians as children of the light. Then one of the Gospel accounts of the resurrection can be read, followed by more joyful meditative singing.

Taizé Community is a monastic order in Taizé, in Burgundy, France. Prayer together, three times a day, is at the heart of life in Taizé. This is a quite simple style of prayer which includes a few songs, a psalm, a Bible reading, a time of silence, and then intercessions. Short songs (chants), sung again and again, give it a meditative character. The words and phrases used in these chants are taken from the Holy Bible or writings of saints. Meditative singing thus becomes a way of listening to God. It allows everyone to take part in a time of prayer together and to remain together in attentive waiting on God.

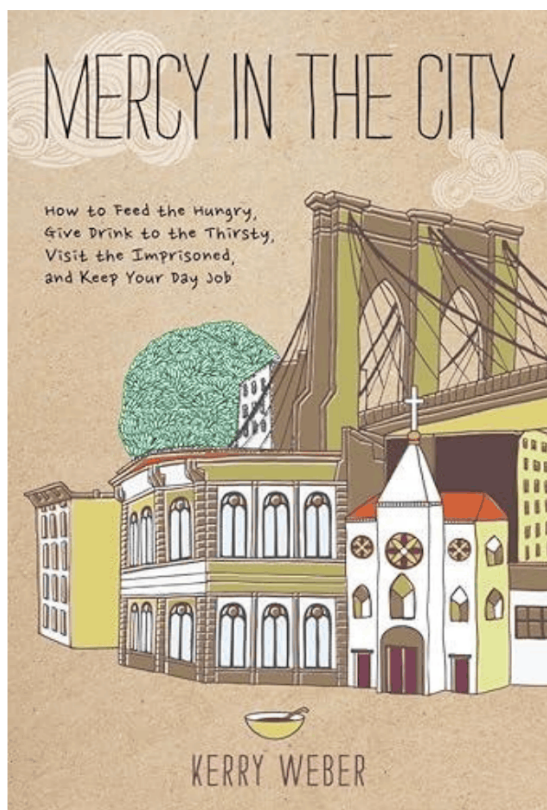

The call to live with mercy, to lead with love, and to remain rooted in Christ

Dear COL Community,

This year, my older son turned ten! At the same time, I realized I have been leading the COL Mission trip to Jamaica for 10 years as well as teaching Theology at Villanova for ten years—an unexpected and meaningful milestone that made me pause in **gratitude**.

Even more, I have been blessed to serve here at Christ Our Light for twelve years, and for over twenty years in Youth Faith Formation. These numbers tell a story far greater than time—they reflect relationships formed, faith deepened, laughter shared, prayers lifted, and the quiet, steady work of God's grace among us.

Together, we have climbed mountains—sometimes literally through rock climbing adventures or on the cliffs of Jamaica—often spiritually through retreats, service, and moments of encounter.

We (my catechists, teens, parents) have sought to live our faith with joy and with hope for a better world. From experiences rooted close to home to moments far beyond—whether at St. Patrick's Cathedral or within the Archdiocese of Los Angeles—each opportunity has been a gift. Our shared mission has carried us around Cherry Hill, Haddonfield, Camden, Philadelphia, Trenton, the Mexico border, Kentucky, Guatemala and Jamaica. In each place, I have been reminded that **the Church is alive, and that faith is most powerful when it is lived together.**

I am deeply grateful for each of you—for your encouragement, your trust, and especially for your prayers, which I have felt so consistently over the years.

- To our dedicated faith formation & administrative staff: thank you for your collaboration, generosity, and steadfast support.
- To our catechists and volunteers: **your witness and commitment have shaped countless lives.**
- To our parents and families: thank you for entrusting me with the privilege of walking alongside your children in faith in the classroom and beyond!
- And to our young people: your openness, energy, and authenticity have been a constant source of inspiration and hope.

As I bring this chapter to a close, I do so with a full heart. I now look ahead to a new season—continuing my studies at Villanova University's School of Business, Church Management, while beginning a new role at Christ the King Parish in Haddonfield, serving in the Office of Evangelization.

I carry with me the same spirit that has guided us here—the **call to live with mercy, to lead with love, and to remain rooted in Christ**. In the days ahead, I will also continue reflecting and writing through *Future of Faith* (www.futureoffaith.org), sharing moments of learning and grace. While this marks a transition, it is not a farewell in the truest sense. The bonds we share in Christ endure beyond place and time.

This is not goodbye—it is simply “until we meet again.” Be assured of my continued prayers for you, just as I ask for yours. With gratitude and hope,

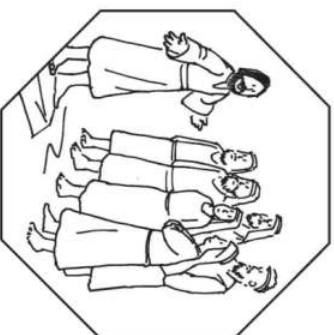
