The Faith Formation office is accepting registrations for religion classes, grades 1 – 8, for the 2026-2027 catechetical year. Families can download, print, complete the forms and submit with the appropriate fee. Go to the parish website to download forms or complete

them online.

Registration deadline is August 18th.

IMPORTANT: Christ Our Light, in compliance with the Diocese of Camden's sacrament guidelines, requires that students have a full year of religion classes prior to preparing for the sacraments of 1st Reconciliation and 1st Eucharist. Students wishing to prepare for the sacrament of Confirmation must attend religion classes consistently from 1st through 8th grade.

Adults:

We offer this form of *Lectio Divina* (sacred reading) for pondering Scripture and for faith sharing with family members and other people.

- Listen/ Read (*Lectio*): Ponder God’s word and listen for what touches your heart.
- Meditate (*Meditatio*): Attend to what you notice. Allow God’s word to resonate in you.
- Speak/Share (*Oratio*): Prayerfully share with Jesus or with the group your thoughts and feelings.
- Rest in God’s presence (*Contemplatio*): Notice God’s presence and be still, surrounded by God’s love.
- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God’s nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

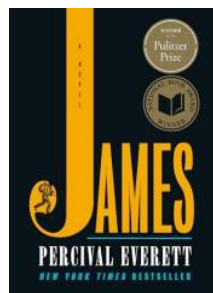

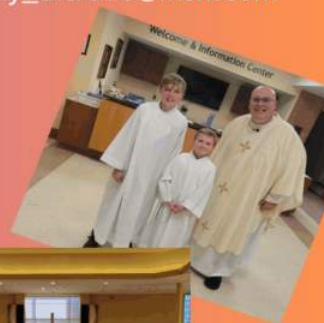

Cool Efficiently. Nearly half of the energy used in your home goes to heating and cooling. So making smart decisions about your home's heating, ventilating, and air conditioning (HVAC) system can have a big effect on your utility bills - as well as on fossil fuel energy consumption and Creation Care! Cooling tips include:

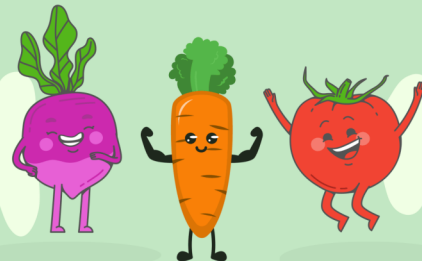
- Cover windows with drapes or shades especially on south and west facing windows.
- Weather-strip doors and windows, then add adequate insulation to keep the heat out.
- Regularly maintain home HVAC equipment and change filters. Programmable thermostats also save money.
- During the hottest part of the day, turn off anything that produces heat such as stoves, dishwashers, lights, etc. Also, consider turning up the thermostat temperature several degrees.
- If your AC is old, consider replacing with an Energy Star rated unit. Better yet, see if replacing it with a highly efficient heat pump will work for you (which can both heat and cool your home). For more info: energystar.gov/products/energy_star_home_upgrade

The Dan Melleby Foundation, Inc. was established to honor the life and legacy of Dan Melleby, a beloved son, brother, friend, teacher, and lifelong Cherry Hill resident. Dan's family are longtime parishioners of Christ Our Light Church.

A graduate of Cherry Hill High School East and Rowan University, Dan began his career as a 5th-grade teacher in Cherry Hill, where he quickly made a lasting impact on his students and colleagues through his kindness, compassion, and dedication to helping others. Dan's life has been described as: *One life lived many lives touched.*

Although Dan's life was tragically cut short at the age of 25, his legacy continues through the Foundation's mission of supporting various youth programs, providing financial support for the homeless and other underserved members of society through the services of Joseph's House, Cathedral Kitchen, and Christ Our Light's annual Adopt-A-Family at Christmas, to name a few. In addition, the Dan Melleby Foundation is committed to promoting mental health initiatives, including suicide prevention.
