Dear Families,

It's with great enthusiasm that I announce the start of an exciting new approach to religious education here at Christ our Light!

The basic idea behind this new program is to teach both the children and to equip their parents with the necessary means and tools to share their faith with their children and family, hence, the title, "Family Faith Formation."

As St. John Paul II said, "the home is the first little Church." This will not only help build up the family that participates, but it will also help foster community and times for us to worship at the Sunday Mass, as one family being invited by Jesus, "Come and See."

Yet, on hearing about this concept, some parents have expressed the concern, "But I'm not trained as a teacher / I don't know enough about our faith / I've never volunteered as a catechist before!" So, on top of the essential material and tools our parish will provide, God has given you his grace to do this!

Statement from the USCCB



Statement from the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops on June 26, 2026

WASHINGTON - This week, the Trump Administration ultimately prevailed in a court challenge to its decision to end temporary protected status (TPS) for Haiti and Syria. Bishop Brendan J. Cahill, chairman of the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops' (USCCB) Committee on Migration, issued the following statement in response:

"Revoking the legal status of hundreds of thousands of people residing in our country creates a moral crisis when returning to their country of origin is not a safe or reasonable option. If we are truly to affirm the God-given dignity of every human person, we as a nation cannot turn a blind eye to such an injustice and the impossible choices it will create for families and communities.

"Even if the Administration determines TPS is no longer warranted, deferred enforced departure remains a tool available to the President, and we urge him to exercise right judgement in this way. Forcibly sending families to dire conditions is a legacy all leaders should seek to avoid. To that end, my brother bishops and I also continue to call upon Congress to act—to meet this moment with the moral fortitude that is so desperately needed."

The USCCB's Committee on Migration has encouraged recent bipartisan efforts in Congress to pass legislation that would require the Secretary of Homeland Security to extend Haiti's TPS designation. In January, Bishop Cahill was also joined by his fellow chairman in calling on the Administration to extend TPS for Haitians.

Sensible water saving tips that can save you money.

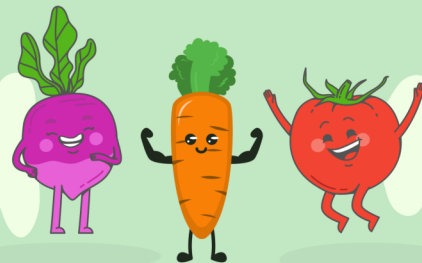
How you use water can have a significant environmental impact over time. It takes a lot of energy to pump the water, to make it safe for use, and to treat the wastewater. Low flow shower heads, washers, toilets and dishwashers reduce water waste and can save you money. Add faucet aerators for more savings and consider turning off the water while you're brushing your teeth or shaving. Fully loading your washers and dishwashers before running also saves water. Got a leaky faucet or toilet? You might be wasting 200 gallons of water a day. Planning on outside watering? Check the forecast for rain. Also, consider drinking tap water (filtered if necessary) instead of bottled water, to reduce packaging waste. The standards the EPA sets for tap water provided by public water suppliers are nearly identical (and test results more transparent) to those that the FDA uses to set bottled water standards. Quality is often similar if standards are met. More water saving tips can be found at <https://www.epa.gov/watersense>

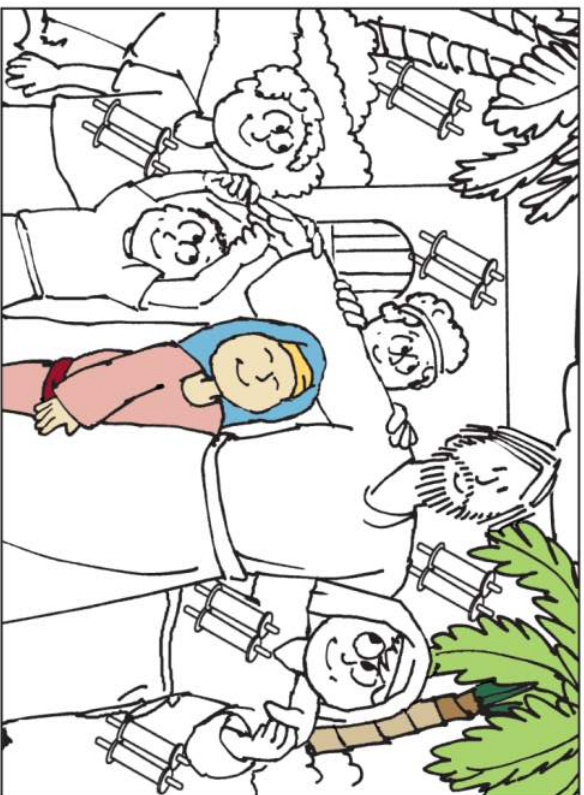

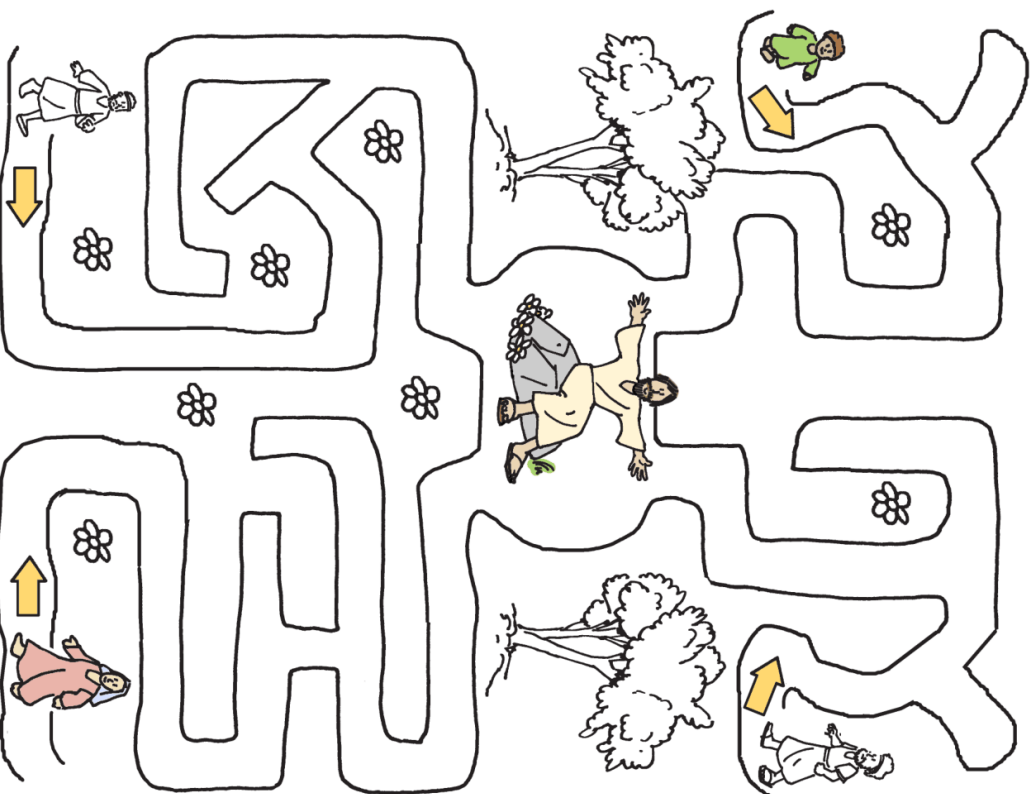

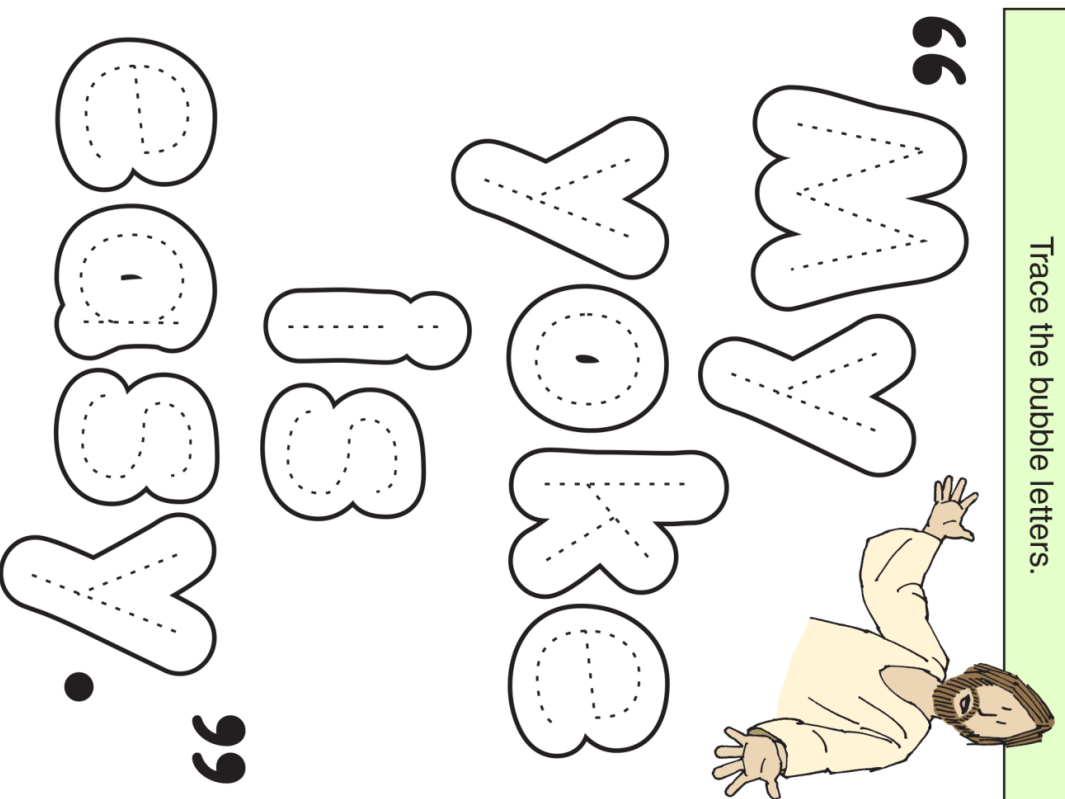
