- Listen/ Read (*Lectio*): Ponder God's word and listen for what touches your heart.
- Meditate (*Meditatio*): Attend to what you notice. Allow God's word to resonate in you.
- Speak/Share (*Oratio*): Prayerfully share with Jesus or with the group your thoughts and feelings.
- Rest in God's presence (*Contemplatio*): Notice God's presence and be still, surrounded by God's love.
- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God's nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

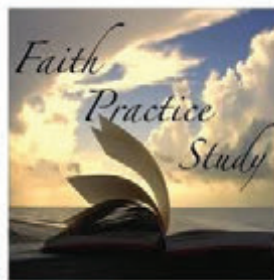
Anointing of the Sick

On Saturday, February 9th at the 4:30 PM Mass and Sunday, February 10th at the 11:00 AM Mass, Christ Our Light will hold the sacrament of Anointing of the Sick.



Suffering and illness have always been among the greatest problems that trouble the human spirit. The sacrament of anointing is the proper sacrament for those whose health is seriously impaired by sickness or old age. Through the sacrament of anointing the Church supports the sick in their struggle against illness and continues Christ's work of healing. All who are united in the bond of a common baptism and a common faith are joined together in the body of Christ since what happens to one member affects all. The sacrament of anointing effectively expresses the share that each one has in the sufferings of others.

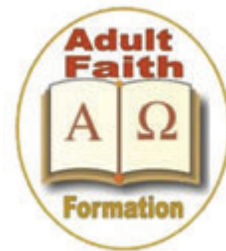

February 11 is World Day of the Sick, an observation introduced by Pope John Paul II as a way for believers to offer prayers for those suffering from illnesses. The day coincides with the commemoration of Our Lady of Lourdes and is an important opportunity for us as a Catholic community to reflect on caring for those who are sick as well as those who provide care to them.

Communal Anointing of the Sick

Saturday, February 9 at the 4:30 Mass

Sunday, February 10 at the 11:00 am Mass

As a Catholic Community, we offer these services to those who are ill:

- We have a prayer list in the bulletin and the people on the list are remembered in prayer (contact parish office 856-667-2440) to be put on the list
- Parish nurses- We have three parish nurses who can visit those who are ill. They do not provide hands on care, but can help navigate care and pray with the person. Contact the parish office
- Communion to the homebound- A team of Eucharistic ministers take communion to the homebound. Most of these teams visit on weekends, but there is also a team that takes communion mid-week. Contact George Sundell (GSundell1@gmail.com or 856-755-0174).
- Helping Hands- Helping Hands can furnish rides to and from doctor's appointments. Contact Judy Bodary (ritasgirl@aol.com or 856-866-1170).
- Prayer Shawl Ministry- Parishioners knit and crochet shawls and lap blankets which are blessed and distributed to those who are ill so that they may be wrapped in prayer. Contact the parish office.
- Stephen Ministry- This is a ministry of one on one caring for those who have experienced loss, grief or are dealing with a crisis in their lives. Contact Pat Slater in the parish office to find out more.
- Caregiver's Support Group- This group meets once a month to support its members in being long-term caregivers. They meet during the day, once a month. Contact the parish office.
- Hospital and Nursing Home Visitation- Volunteers take communion to residents of local nursing homes and assisted living facilities. We serve Kennedy Hospital, Cherry Hill Senior Living, Bancroft Nursing Home, Springhills Assisted Living, Avista and Arden Court. - Cancer Care Ministry- We are currently training a class of parishioners to become cancer care ministers for persons with cancer and their families. They should be commissioned by early spring.
- Sacrament of the sick- If you or a loved one needs to be anointed, please contact the parish office. This is the sacrament of the sick and not "last rites." This can be done at your home or in the hospital.
- Just a note: hospitals no longer inform churches if you have been admitted to the hospital. If you have been admitted and would like a visit from a priest or staff person, please contact the parish office. 856-667-2440

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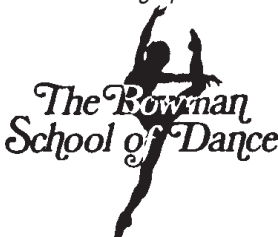
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
