Luke 5:1-11

Adults:

When have you felt inadequate to a task or role you were given? How did you respond?

Adult: We offer this form of *Lectio Divina* (sacred reading) for pondering Scripture and for faith sharing with family members and other people.

- Listen/ Read (*Lectio*): Ponder God's word and listen for what touches your heart.
- Meditate (*Meditatio*): Attend to what you notice. Allow God's word to resonate in you.
- Speak/Share (*Oratio*): Prayerfully share with Jesus or with the group your thoughts and feelings.
- Rest in God's presence (*Contemplatio*): Notice God's presence and be still, surrounded by God's love.
- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God's nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

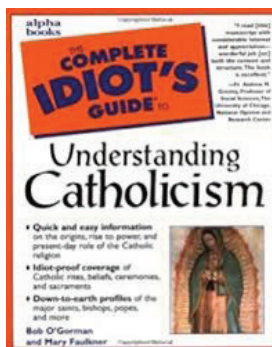

HOUSE OF CHARITY BISHOP'S ANNUAL APPEAL

The House of Charity provides the day-to-day operational income that supports the pastoral, charitable and social ministries of the Diocese, including: Catholic Charities, support for seminarian education and housing for retired priests, support for Vitality Catholic Healthcare Services, support for Catholic education, as well as support for our various pastoral ministries.

The House of Charity – Bishop's Annual Appeal supports people to people ministries that serve the South Jersey Community today. In service, we encounter those in need where they are, accompany them on their journey and bring them to a place of hope.

Monies that are raised in this fiscal year are expended next fiscal year. Without the House of Charity, the Diocese could not fulfill the mission that Christ gave us to care for His people.



CATHOLIC STRONG CAMPAIGN FOR THE CATHOLIC COMMUNITY OF SOUTH JERSEY

Of the funds raised through the Catholic Strong campaign, 70% will remain at the parish. There is no single case statement because each parish has been asked to identify their unique needs and way they will put their dollars to use. These needs could include updates to physical plant needs, new or expanded youth and pastoral ministries, and the hiring of staff to expand the effectiveness of parishes. Whatever the individual case, each parish has had the opportunity to identify their own needs and how they would like to spend the dollars raised to meet those needs.

At the same time, 30% of the dollars raised will be returned to the Diocese for use in creating new religious education, addiction support, and other ministries that cannot be supported by current funding sources. In addition, new evangelization efforts will be established to reach out to non-Catholics, people living on the fringes of our society, and to those who have left the faith.

Center for FaithJustice receives Lilly Endowment Grant for "Strengthening Congregational Ministries with Youth"

LAWRENCEVILLE, NJ – The Center for FaithJustice (CFJ) has received a grant to help congregations design, test and implement new models for nurturing the religious lives of middle and high school youth and for engaging them more fully in the congregations' mission and ministries.

CFJ received grant funding for its project "NeXI Level: The WorX Continues." The project is designed to institute youth-led parish-wide campaigns rooted in service and justice at select participating Catholic congregations across the greater New Jersey region. NeXI Level will build on the core tenets of CFJ's long-standing and proven WorX program model and empower youth participants to take their passions to the "neXI level" within their home parish communities. The objective is to pilot this initiative at six parishes in 2019 and then expand its scope in 2020 and beyond. The total grant is for five years.

World Day of the Sick- February 11

February 11 is World Day of the Sick, an observation introduced by Pope John Paul II as a way for believers to offer prayers for those suffering from illnesses. The day coincides with the commemoration of Our Lady of Lourdes and is an important opportunity for us as a Catholic community to reflect on caring for those who are sick as well as those who provide care to them.

Communal Anointing of the Sick

As a Catholic Community, we offer these services to those who are ill:

- We have a prayer list in the bulletin and the people on the list are remembered in prayer (contact parish office 856-667-2440) to be put on the list
- Parish nurses- We have three parish nurses who can visit those who are ill. They do not provide hands on care, but can help navigate care and pray with the person. Contact the parish office
- Communion to the homebound- A team of Eucharistic ministers take communion to the homebound. Most of these teams visit on weekends, but there is also a team that takes communion mid-week. Contact George Sundell (GSundell1@gmail.com or 856-755-0174).
- Helping Hands- Helping Hands can furnish rides to and from doctor's appointments. Contact Judy Bodary (ritasgirl@aol.com or 856-866-1170).
- Prayer Shawl Ministry- Parishioners knit and crochet shawls and lap blankets which are blessed and distributed to those who are ill so that they may be wrapped in prayer. Contact the parish office.
- Stephen Ministry- This is a ministry of one on one caring for those who have experienced loss, grief or are dealing with a crisis in their lives. Contact Pat Slater in the parish office to find out more.
- Caregiver's Support Group- This group meets once a month to support its members in being long-term caregivers. They meet during the day, once a month. Contact the parish office.
- Hospital and Nursing Home Visitation- Volunteers take communion to residents of local nursing homes and assisted living facilities. We serve Kennedy Hospital, Cherry Hill Senior Living, Bancroft Nursing Home, Springhills Assisted Living, Avista and Arden Court. - Cancer Care Ministry- We are currently training a class of parishioners to become cancer care ministers for persons with cancer and their families. They should be commissioned by early spring.
- Sacrament of the sick- If you or a loved one needs to be anointed, please contact the parish office. This is the sacrament of the sick and not "last rites." This can be done at your home or in the hospital.
- Just a note: hospitals no longer inform churches if you have been admitted to the hospital. If you have been admitted and would like a visit from a priest or staff person, please contact the parish office. 856-667-2440

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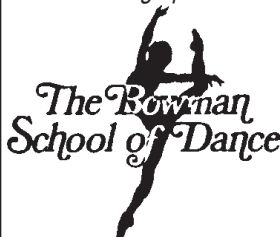
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
