Courageous Conversations



Late last fall, Christ Our Light held our first Courageous Conversation. Parishioners came together to talk about their reactions and feelings brought about by the scandal

caused by the sexual abuse perpetrated by members of the clergy and covered up by the bishops of our church. We took time to pray for the victims of abuse and for ourselves as members of a broken church. We took time to share stories and listen to one another, some of us knowing individuals who had been abused by priests. We expressed frustration with continued disclosures of abuse, outrage that such heinous acts were committed by priests, and sadness that any victims have been treated poorly by church leadership. It is heartbreaking to learn of the suffering of the victims, and to hear that leaders in our church opted for scandal-management over the protection of children and the well-being of adults.

With the recent release of name of priests from the diocese of Camden who were credibly accused of abuse, in addition to those of the other dioceses in the State of New Jersey, there is an even greater need to gather again and participate in a courageous conversation. This gathering will provide time for parishioners, and anyone else who is interested, to come together to pray and to discuss how the abuses perpetrated by clergy/church leadership are affecting individuals in the church. The deep sadness, anger, confusion, pain, disillusionment and distrust that people are experiencing are natural responses for people who try to reconcile love for their faith with the failings of Church leadership.

We need safe places and relationships to face this reality, and become more aware of how it affects our community. We need opportunities to gather together to reflect, pray, and listen to each other to discover and assign meanings to this experience. Any chance for healing needs to begin in safe, caring, and honest conversation, rooted in the never ending love of God. Trained facilitators will help guide us in small groups, and will be available for individual conversations as needed.

Please join us on **Sunday, March 3, from 3-5 PM** to engage in **Courageous Conversations** that can help move us forward into the healing and hope that Christ, who is our Light, promises. 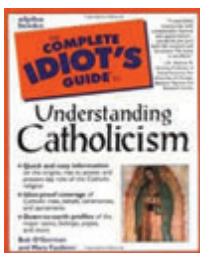

Let's Drive NJ - The Importance of NJ Assembly Bill A4743

Currently in New Jersey, anyone applying for or renewing a NJ driver's license must produce documents which add up to 6 points. These documents must show proof of identity and residency and, for an initial license, proof of your Social Security number.

While this seems easy, thousands of New Jerseyans each year are denied a license because of their circumstances, including seniors, those who are homeless, displaced or without identification, victims of domestic violence, those who are transgender, those who may have been incarcerated and those who are undocumented. A great majority of these people want and need to drive to get to work, take children to school, access medical services, buy food and other necessities of life. Currently, they have no choice but to drive illegally. They cannot take a drivers test or obtain insurance which presents a clear and present danger to themselves and others.

Assembly Bill A4743 creates two categories of driver's licenses and identification cards. Persons will be able to apply for a standard driver's license which gives them full driving privileges or for a REAL ID, effective October, 2020, which gives full driving privileges and can also be used as identification to fly domestically or enter certain federal buildings. The REAL ID will require the more stringent documentation.

For the standard driver's license, NJ residents will have to have satisfactory proof of identity and age, two documents providing proof of residency in New Jersey and proof of a social security number. For those who do not have a social security number, they must indicate to MVC, in the manner prescribed, that they are not eligible for social security. They will not have to have documents to prove lawful presence in the US.

The standard driver's license **will not** be considered evidence of citizenship or immigration status, cannot be used as identification to fly domestically or to enter certain federal facilities, **nor** can it be used as a basis for investigation, arrest, citation, prosecution or detention.

What are the benefits of A4743

- Improves roadway safety with more licensed and insured drivers.
- Expands driver's licenses to NJ residents regardless of immigration status and for so many others unable to comply with points for Real ID because of life's circumstances.
- Benefits employers and their employees who depend upon cars for work and all those who need cars to access much needed services for themselves and their families.
- Increases the revenue of MVC and the auto insurance industry and generates more car sales.
- A4743 is a win/win for NJ residents and legislation that Governor Murphy has pledged to sign.

What can you do to support the Bill?

Sign the Let's Drive NJ petition which will be forwarded to the legislature. Call Assemblyman Coughlin's office at 732-855-7441 and ask that he introduce A4743 on the floor of the Assembly for a vote. Call your legislators in the Assembly and ask them to advocate for this bill.

Next week we will provide an opportunity to sign petitions for this bill in the gathering space following all Masses.

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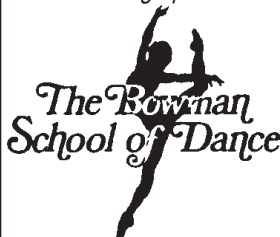
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
