This weekend is Commitment Weekend for our diocesan-wide campaign, **Catholic Strong**. This one-woman play tells the incredible story of Rwandan genocide survivor Immaculée Ilibagiza, a modern day messenger of hope and forgiveness. Immaculée spent 91 days in hiding with six other women in a small bathroom, and prayer led her beyond fear and rage to a deep, intimate connection to God and ultimately to freedom.

This off-broadway show has received great acclaim in its run to being named the Official Artistic Representation for the 25th Anniversary of the Rwandan Genocide. The United Nations remembers this event each year on April 7, in hopes that we "nurture the courage to care and the resolve to act...and ensure that what happened in Rwanda is never repeated, anywhere, every again."

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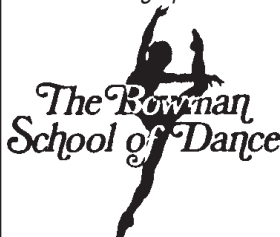
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
