- Speak/Share (*Oratio*): Prayerfully share with Jesus or with the group your thoughts and feelings.
- Rest in God's presence (*Contemplatio*): Notice God's presence and be still, surrounded by God's love.
- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God's nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

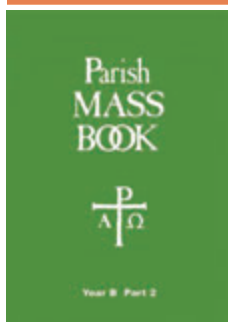

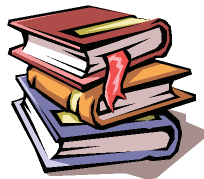

Barking to the Choir

by Gregory Boyle, founder of
Homeboy Industries

In a moving example of unconditional love in difficult times, Gregory Boyle, the Jesuit priest and *New York Times* bestselling author of *Tattoos on the Heart*, shares what working with gang members in Los Angeles has taught him about faith, compassion, and the enduring power of kinship.

In a nation deeply divided and plagued by poverty and violence, *Barking to the Choir* offers a snapshot into the challenges and joys of life on the margins. Sergio, arrested at age nine, in a gang by age twelve, and serving time shortly thereafter, now works with a substance-abuse team to help others find sobriety. New father Cuco, who never knew his own dad, thinks of a daily adventure on which to take his four-year-old son. These former gang members uplift the soul and reveal how bright life can be when filled with unconditional love and kindness.

This book is guaranteed to shake up our ideas about God and about people with a glimpse at a world defined by more compassion and fewer barriers. Gently and humorously, *Barking to the Choir* invites us to find kinship with one another and re-convinces us all of our own goodness.

We will read the book over the summer and then meet in small groups in the fall to discuss the book, followed by a large group event to conclude this year's program. All members of the parish community are invited and encouraged to participate in this program so that we continue to grow as One Parish, Christ Our Light! Further details will be shared in May. The Elementary Faith Formation office is accepting registrations for students grade Pre-K through 8 for the catechetical year beginning September 2019. Families whose children currently attend classes at COL have received re-registration materials, with completed forms and fees due by May 30, 2019. Families new to Elementary Faith Formation (Pre-K – 6th) or Youth Faith Formation (7th & 8th) can access registration forms from the parish website, or families can register and pay online. Online registration includes a \$3.00 processing fee. See the parish website homepage for more information. NOTE: Children must attend Elementary Faith Formation class for one year prior to preparing to celebrate 1st Reconciliation and 1st Eucharist. Families are encouraged to begin their child's faith formation in first grade.

NOTE: COL will offer a 5th grade EFF class on Monday & Tuesday afternoon as well as Wednesday evening. Cherry Hill Public School 5th grade students have opportunities to participate in All Cherry Hill Chorus and other activities whose practice times are Monday afternoons. If your 5th grader may possibly qualify for these extra curricula activities please register them for the Tuesday or Wednesday class.

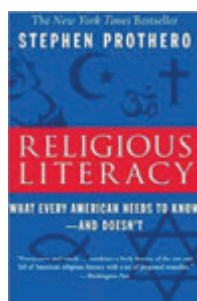
"Friends & Family" CPR Instruction Class given by American Heart Association Instructors. *This is CPR for the lay person.*

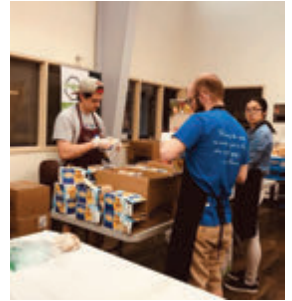

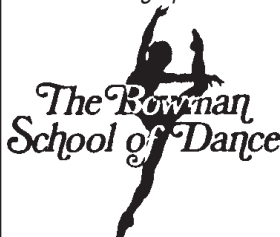
