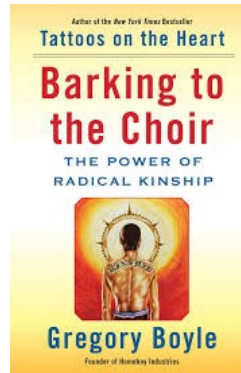

- ...the ultimate measure of health in any community might well reside in our ability to stand in awe at what folks have to carry rather than in judgement at how they carry it. ... Judgement, after all, takes up the room you need for loving.

CHILDREN'S LITURGY OF THE WORD (CLOW)

CLOW has resumed during the 9am & 11am Mass in mid-September. Don't know what this is all about? CLOW are the Sunday readings in language appropriate for children. The homily is interactive with an adult facilitator overseeing the Q & A format.

Children ages 5 years to those in 5th grade are invited to be dismissed from the main church and proceed to the Ministry Center where they listen to the Sunday readings. They participate in the homily and return to their parents for the Offertory. Children younger than 5 years of age should remain with their parents

VOLUNTEERS ARE NEEDED FOR CLOW

- Adults and teens are needed to proclaim and share the Word of God
- Requirements: enthusiasm and the willingness to share your faith with the children of Christ Our Light Parish
- Scheduling is approximately once a month
- All materials are provided and mailed home the week before you are scheduled
- Facilitators do not have to come up with ideas – just present them and, most of all, let the children LEAD you.
- Feel free to come back with the children during a CLOW session to observe.
- Facilitators have commented that they learn so much from the children
- As one child said, "CLOW helps me understand; I don't understand all those big words."

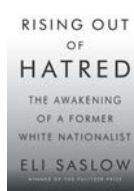

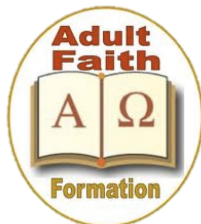

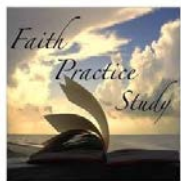

Diocesan Victim Compensation Program

NJ Independent Victims Compensation Program



The Diocese of Camden – along with the other Roman Catholic dioceses in New Jersey – has established an Independent Victim Compensation Program (IVCP) to compensate those who, as children or young adults, were sexually abused by a priest of the Diocese. The IVCP is independently administered by experienced victim compensation experts Kenneth R. Feinberg and Camille S. Biros.

The IVCP will handle the submission, evaluation and resolution of individual claims, and operates independently of the Diocese or any church-affiliated institution. The administrators of the IVCP have complete autonomy to determine the eligibility of a claim with the guidelines of the established Protocol. The amount of compensation for those who make a claim will be independently determined by the IVCP administrators. All victims – no matter when the abuse occurred – are eligible to participate, and all matters will be handled confidentially.

Victims of clergy sexual abuse of a minor can begin the process of utilizing the program by going to www.njdiocesesisivcp.com and reviewing the protocol for submitting a claim.

Bishop Sullivan strongly encourages anyone who was sexually victimized by a priest of the Diocese to participate in the IVCP, and has asked that anyone who knows of someone who was abused to contact them so that they are aware of the IVCP and can participate in it.

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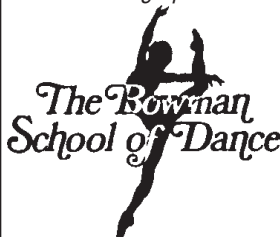
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
