Catholic Strong Update



Through the tremendous generosity of you, the parishioners of Christ Our Light, we have our two initial projects in the works. The first project is the renovation of the Convent kitchen and laundry room. As you might know, the Convent kitchen has never been renovated or updated since it was built in the 1960's, with the exception of new appliances. We have

just gotten approval from the diocese to accept the lowest of four bids to renovate the Convent kitchen. Work will begin in two weeks.

Our second project is the replacement of the curtain wall (windows and panels) of the school. We have received the first of three required bids for this project and will need to get two more bids. The diocesan buildings department, as well as the Christ Our Light Finance Council and the members of the Facilities committee of the School Board are all involved in this project. We hope to begin this work this coming summer.

Charitable Giving

Year-End Charitable Giving via a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD)



If you are looking to lower your taxable income, you may want to consider a QCD. If you are age 70½ or older, IRS rules require you to take required minimum distributions (RMDs) each year from your tax-deferred retirement accounts. This additional taxable income may push you into a higher tax bracket and may also reduce your eligibility for certain tax credits and deductions. To eliminate or reduce the impact of RMD income, charitably inclined investors may want to consider making a qualified charitable distribution (QCD).

A QCD is a direct transfer of funds from an IRA custodian, payable to a qualified charity, as described in the QCD provision in the Internal Revenue Code. Amounts distributed as a QCD can be counted toward satisfying your RMD for the year, up to \$100,000, and can also be excluded from your taxable income. This is not the case with a regular withdrawal from an IRA, even if you use the money to make a charitable contribution later on. In this scenario, the funds would be counted as taxable income even if you later offset that income with the charitable contribution deduction. Please consult a tax advisor to learn more. If you are 70½ or older, own an IRA, and donate to charity, QCDs may make sense for you; consult a tax advisor regarding your specific situation.

We will begin our giving tree and gifts for the residents of Barclay Nursing Home at the beginning of December. We are beginning the adopt-a-family program earlier because donors have requested this in order to take advantage of holiday sales.

Important Legislation

Supporting NJ Senate Bill S3229 and Assembly Bill A4743

Currently two important pieces of legislation are in committee in the NJ legislature, S3449 and A4743, both of which would create two categories of drivers' licenses and identification cards, allow residents unable to prove lawful presence in the US to receive permits and standard driver's licenses or identification cards, and permit the MVC to increase certain fees.

The bill is important to the community as it would create two different licenses, Real ID and "standard," both of which are federally compliant. The standard license will allow residents including many senior citizens, homeless people, undocumented immigrants, victims of domestic violence and others who lack certain documentation to obtain a driver's license, though it cannot be used as identification to fly domestically or internationally or to enter a federal building. For those situations, an accompanying passport would be required.

Residents of New Jersey deserve roadway safety for all. Enactment of **S3229/A4743** will improve roadway safety. It will be good for the economy and it will enable those residents who lack sufficient documentation for the Real ID to better support themselves and their families. There are many helpful provisions to the bill that include:

S3229/A4743:

- Applicants for either license would be required to pass the driving exam and obtain car insurance if they are driving a vehicle.
- Homeless people would be eligible for a fee waiver if they submit proof of temporary residence through a social worker or the coordinator of an emergency shelter.
- Under the legislation, any person who knowingly discloses any false documents or personal information would be subject to a crime in the fourth degree, which would include a fine of up to \$500 or jail time, and a ban of 180 days from getting a license.
- The bill would create an 11-person advisory board, appointed by the governor and state majority leaders, to review the law's implementation which would end after one year.

The bill currently sits in the Senate Transportation Committee and the Assembly Judiciary Committee. Please ask your NJ Senators and Assemblypersons that S3229/A4743 be included in the next committee agenda so that the legislative process can move forward. Letters for your signature are available to sign after masses on Nov. 16 and Nov. 17. You can also call the offices of your legislators and express your support for the bill.

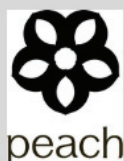

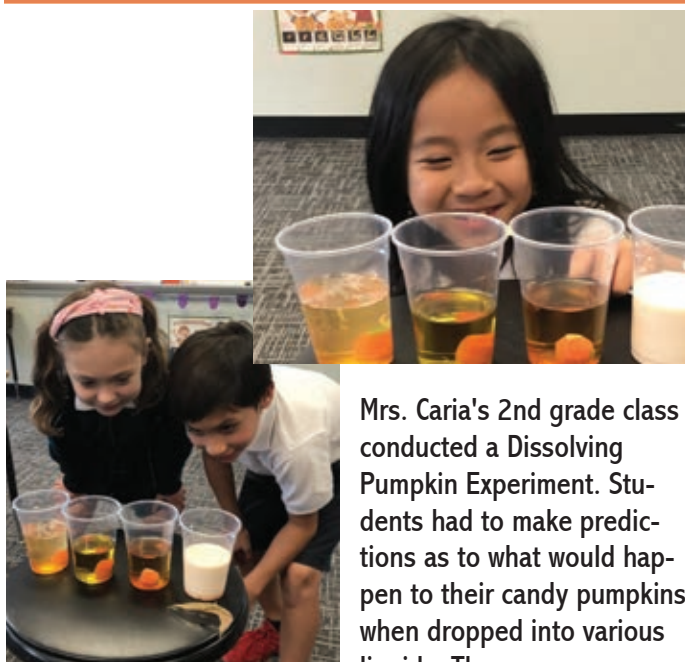


GIRLS VARSITY VOLLEYBALL

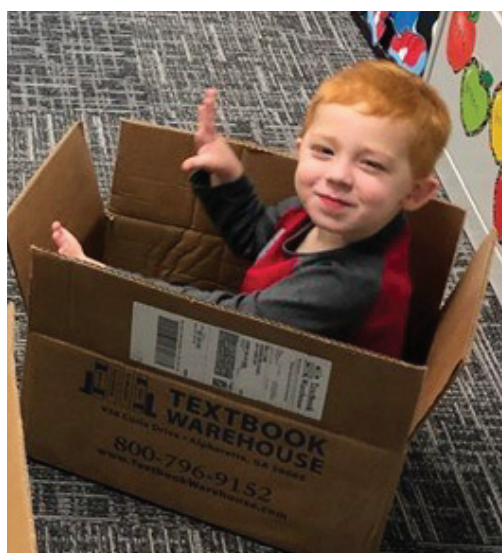
DISSOLVING PUMPKINS

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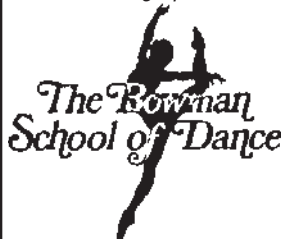
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
