- Meditate (*Meditatio*): Attend to what you notice. Allow God's word to resonate in you.
- Speak/Share (*Oratio*): Prayerfully share with Jesus or with the group your thoughts and feelings.
- Rest in God's presence (*Contemplatio*): Notice God's presence and be still, surrounded by God's love.
- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God's nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

Sunday of the Word of God



Today is the Sunday of the Word of God.

Did you know? In the proclamation of the Word, Christ Jesus, Our Light, is made present in our midst in the Sunday assembly. It is not only in the bread and wine become Body and Blood where Jesus becomes real, but also when the scripture readings for the mass are proclaimed. Pope Francis is inviting Catholics across the world to deepen their appreciation, love and faithful witness to God and his Word. That's why, as established by a papal decree late last year, the Third Sunday in Ordinary Time, January 26 (this year), is to be observed as a special day devoted to "the celebration, study and dissemination of the Word of God." The Pope encourages us to read and pray with Sacred Scripture, lingering over it so that God's Word can speak to our hearts, and "stimulate believers [each one of us!] to be living instruments of transmission of the Word," and to keep in mind the integral relationship of the Word and the Eucharist.

You'll notice that the ambo (from where sacred scripture is proclaimed) is enhanced with flowers and candles this weekend, and the Book of the Gospels is enthroned in front of it. This symbolizes how we are to carry the Word with us after we have heard it proclaimed at Mass, and hold it with deep reverence as the Word will mold and shape us as we share it with those we meet everyday.

- canned vegetables (corn and green beans are the most popular)
- canned meals like Chef Boy-ar-dee, chili or stew. (Especially good for people who live in motels)
- canned fruit, baked beans
- pancake mix (please purchase complete mixes that do not need eggs or oil), syrup
- boxed mashed potatoes, rice
- noodle side dishes, mac and cheese
- cereal, crackers
- peanut butter and jelly
- coffee (caned, not K-cups), sugar, cooking oil
- toilet paper, laundry detergent

Please do check expiration dates before donating items. Your donations can be left in the hallway that is to the right of the gathering space as you enter. St. Vincent Mission David, Kentucky **May 17-23, 20120 and June 28- July 4, 2020**

Focus is on home repair, painting and helping create home gardens— all skill levels welcome
Cost is approximately \$400 which covers program fee, housing and meals. Fee does not cover transportation to and from Kentucky. (car pooling)
Open to adults and middle school students and older when accompanied by an adult.



La Puerta Guatemala **To be scheduled— late July or early August** Cost is approximately \$1400

Focus is on a ministry of presence. The team works with children on an experience similar to Vacation Bible School and a faith-sharing retreat with adults. You do not need to speak Spanish. Fee covers airfare, housing, in-country transportation and food with the exception of three meals. Open to adults and middle school students and older when accompanied by an adult.

Montego Bay, Jamaica **August 15-22**

Focus is working with adults or children with mental and/or physical disabilities through Mustard Seed Communities as well as involvement in other service projects at sites run by Mustard Seed. Cost of airfare is approximately \$600 We ask team members to raise \$950 which covers food, housing, insurance, day trip to the beach, restaurant evening out, and supports the mission of Mustard Seed Communities. Trip is open to students age 16 and older. Families are welcome to accompany their teens.

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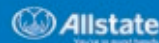
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
