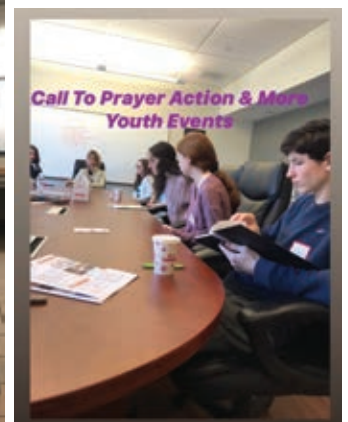

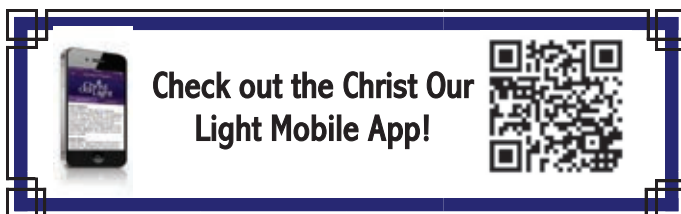


Good Morning Moms
