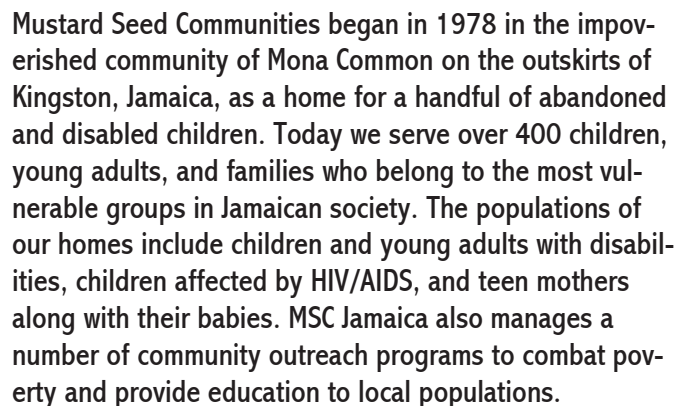

Stations of the Cross 2020

One of the rich traditions of the Catholic Church is the gathering of the faithful to pray the Stations of the Cross – a ritual that helps us unite with the passion of Jesus Christ beginning with his agony in the garden and taking us through His death on the cross and His burial in a borrowed tomb. The fourteen stations recall events such as Jesus' trial before Pontius Pilate, His tortuous walk with the cross to the hill of Calvary, His encounters with Mary his mother and others and finally His offering of His life as a measure of His total love for us.



In the early years of the Church following Christ's ascension into heaven, Christians would make pilgrimages to Jerusalem to walk the way of the cross reflecting on His love and His command that we love and serve others – particularly those who need our prayers and our help. The spiritual graces of the stations were so great that our church leaders were moved to direct that the Stations of the Cross be erected in every Catholic church for the benefit of those who could not journey to Jerusalem.

The modern depictions of the fourteen stations present in the wings of the COL sanctuary were created from materials from the Lafferty family farm--land upon which our church now stands. Recognizing our diversity, the Catholic Community of Christ Our Light will offer a variety of prayer forms as we gather for the Stations of the Cross on each Friday of Lent this year. 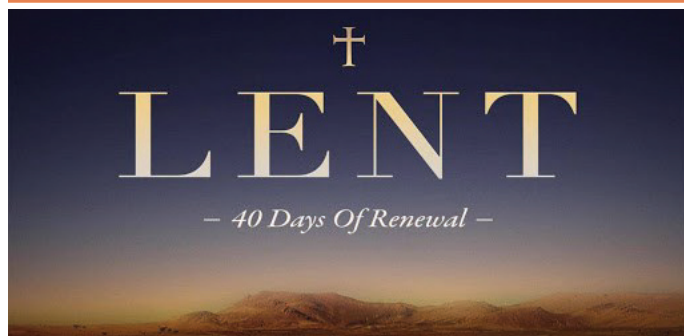

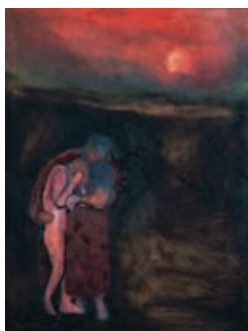
I Thirst Initiative



Recovery, Spirituality, 12 Steps

Christ Our Light has been asked to pilot a new diocesan initiative to address the challenges of addiction and respond in faith to the opioid epidemic with a new form of ministry. We need you to answer the call to this ministry, and help us change the direction of this deadly epidemic.

I THIRST is a program designed to empower the Church to be a resource for those suffering from addictions and their families. Addiction is a defining problem of society, with physiological, and mental health components which must be addressed. Ultimately, however, the desolation, the abandonment and the guilt which are all 'hallmarks' of the addicted life, are in many ways spiritual problems which require a spiritual remedy. The I THIRST program seeks to provide this spiritual remedy to those suffering from addiction and their families.



We will hold an introductory session for this 30 hour ministry training program on Thursday, April 4, 7 PM. Training sessions for the ministry will be held on Friday evenings, 6:30-9:30 PM and Saturday mornings, 8:30-11:30 AM on the following dates: April 17/18, May 1/2, June 12/13, June 26/27, July 10/11.
