The Word

Reading for March 15, 2020

John 4:5-15, 19b-26, 39a, 40-42

Adults:

Where have you found a source of “living water” for your own journey of faith?

We offer this form of *Lectio Divina* (sacred reading) for pondering Scripture and for faith sharing with family members and other people.

- Listen/ Read (*Lectio*): Ponder God’s word and listen for what touches your heart.
- Meditate (*Meditatio*): Attend to what you notice. Allow God’s word to resonate in you.
- Speak/Share (*Oratio*): Prayerfully share with Jesus or with the group your thoughts and feelings.
- Rest in God’s presence (*Contemplatio*): Notice God’s presence and be still, surrounded by God’s love.
- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God’s nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

Teens:

Jesus revealed himself to an outcast of society. How can you be “living water” to the outcasts of your school? Society? The world?

Children:

How do you experience Jesus helping and loving you?

From the Pastor - Coronavirus Statement



Fr. Tom Newton, the Pastor of Christ Our Light has issued the following statement:

Due to the on-going flu season and the threat of contracting the corona virus, beginning today we will ask all parishioners to refrain from shaking hands at the sign of peace and shaking hands with the clergy before and after Mass. We encourage parishioners to wave or smile to each other during the sign of peace.

We will not discontinue the distribution of the precious blood at this time. However, if one is sick, coughing, sneezing or just not feeling well we ask those individuals to refrain from consuming from the cup until you feel better and are over all of your illness symptoms. All Clergy and Eucharistic Ministers who distribute the Eucharist are reminded, once again, to wash and sanitize your hands prior to the distribution of communion and refrain from touching your face, eyes, ears, nose, and hair before giving out communion. If a Eucharistic Minister is sick, coughing and sneezing or exhibiting any other flu-like symptoms, he or she is not permitted to distribute communion until he or she is better.

The only person who must drink from the cup at every Mass is the priest celebrant. For this reason the priest will use a separate cup in case he has a cold. I believe that reception of the Precious Blood is an important part of participating fully in the Mass but it is not essential for the full reception of Jesus in the Eucharist. So if you are sick exercise the option to refrain from the cup to keep others healthy.

We continue to remember and pray for all those who are sick and suffering in any way. We pray for their healing.

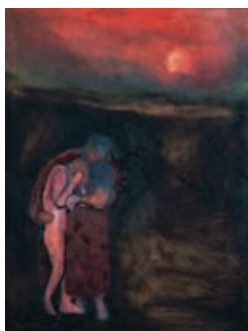
I Thirst Initiative



Recovery, Spirituality, 12 Steps

Christ Our Light has been asked to pilot a new diocesan initiative to address the challenges of addiction and respond in faith to the opioid epidemic with a new form of ministry. We need you to answer the call to this ministry, and help us change the direction of this deadly epidemic.

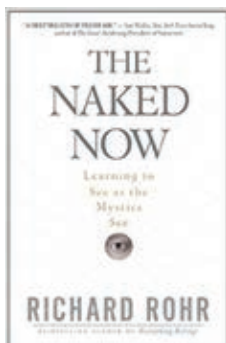
I THIRST is a program designed to empower the Church to be a resource for those suffering from addictions and their families. Addiction is a defining problem of society, with physiological, and mental health components which must be addressed. Ultimately, however, the desolation, the abandonment and the guilt which are all 'hallmarks' of the addicted life, are in many ways spiritual problems which require a spiritual remedy. The I THIRST program seeks to provide this spiritual remedy to those suffering from addiction and their families.



We will hold an introductory session for this 30 hour ministry training program on Thursday, April 2, 7 PM. Training sessions for the ministry will be held on Friday evenings, 6:30-9:30 PM and Saturday mornings, 8:30-11:30 AM on the following dates: April 17/18, May 1/2, June 12/13, June 26/27, July 10/11.
