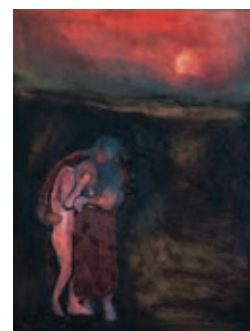
I Thirst Initiative



Recovery, Spirituality, 12 Steps

Christ Our Light has been asked to pilot a new diocesan initiative to address the challenges of addiction and respond in faith to the opioid epidemic with a new form of ministry. We need you to answer the call to this ministry, and help us change the direction of this deadly epidemic.

I THIRST is a program designed to empower the Church to be a resource for those suffering from addictions and their families. Addiction is a defining problem of society, with physiological, and mental health components which must be addressed. Ultimately, however, the desolation, the abandonment and the guilt which are all 'hallmarks' of the addicted life, are in many ways spiritual problems which require a spiritual remedy. The I THIRST program seeks to provide this spiritual remedy to those suffering from addiction and their families.



We will hold an introductory session for this 30 hour ministry training program on Thursday, April 2, 7 PM. Training sessions for the ministry will be held on Friday evenings, 6:30-9:30 PM and Saturday mornings, 8:30-11:30 AM on the following dates: April 17/18, May 1/2, June 12/13, June 26/27, July 10/11.

Updated Statement Regarding Coronavirus



FROM THE PASTOR

- Bishop Sullivan has already dispensed the faithful from the obligation to participate in Sunday Mass. In accord with the Governor's directive to limit gatherings to no more than fifty people, Bishop Sullivan now directs that all public weekday and Sunday Masses be suspended beginning no later than Wednesday, March 18, 2020 and until further notice. Public weekday Masses are not to be held even if attendance is fewer than fifty since, generally speaking, it is the older faithful who are most vulnerable who usually attend.
- In addition, all public prayer services, Holy Hours, and Stations of the Cross are also suspended until further notice. We will also suspend the celebration of Confessions until further notice.
- A decision regarding the celebration of First Reconciliation will be communicated to the parents by Mrs. Grogan.
- The Church will be open for private prayer between 6:00 AM and 6:00 PM every day.
- Parishioners are still invited and encouraged to drop off food supplies for the parish food pantry and the Diocesan FaithFULL food drive to benefit the Cherry Hill Food Pantry between 6:00 AM and 6:00 PM.

- All other parish activities are suspended until further notice.

Cherry Hill Food Pantry - Mall Walk

As you might expect, we will be cancelling the Mall Walk scheduled for March 29 due to the Corona virus pandemic.



We invested a lot of time setting up the walk and requested donations from our friends, neighbors, volunteers and supporters. Many of them have already registered and donated. We have \$2,900 in donations as of today. To keep that momentum going we will now have a "Virtual" Mall Walk to Fight Hunger instead of an actual one.

Lenten story: The Joy of Learning

Maria Ana begins each morning by thanking God for a new day. After saying her prayers and taking a bath, she helps her mother make tortillas before she puts on her uniform and walks to school with her two younger brothers.



"I feel happy when I'm studying," says Maria Ana, whose favorite subjects are math, science and physical education. In school, Maria Ana also learns about ways she and her family can stay healthy, including washing fruits and vegetables before eating them. And, Maria Ana is able to bring some of that nutritious food home with her, thanks to the CRS school lunch program.

Maria Ana is especially grateful to her father, Don Cristobal, for working hard to send her to school. "My father works every day to support us, to provide the food that we need and to earn money to pay for school."

Trinh's father, Vinh, is also proud of his daughter for her studies. "My lovely daughter, Trinh, is healthy, athletic and loved by her friends at school. I hope she can get into university and be a role model for her sister."

"My parents didn't send us to school," Vinh says. "Now, as a parent, I want my children educated so they can contribute to our community."

That's why Trinh rides her bike to school everyday. Her favorite subject is English, and her favorite game is tung bung, which is played with a jump rope. In addition to traditional school subjects, a special CRS program teaches students ways to keep their families and their homes safe when typhoons hit. Trinh shares this information with her parents, and now the family is better prepared for dangerous weather. They know to take cows to a safe, high place and to put food on the top shelf during storms so it will not wash away or spoil.



"Going to school," says Trinh, "helps us understand more."

Just like Trinh and Maria Ana, Yvone's family works hard to send her to school. Her grandparents believe that having an education is an advantage in life and want all of their grandchildren to have the opportunity to go to school. Her grandfather, Eliakim, sold 42 heads of cattle to pay for his children's education.

Yvone's grandmother, Patricia, says: "I have a dream for my children to study and to be able to do anything possible to earn a living."

Girls' education has a huge impact on all of society

Educated women are less likely to die in childbirth: If all mothers completed primary education, maternal deaths would be reduced by two-thirds, saving 98,000 lives. In sub-Saharan Africa, if all women completed primary education, maternal deaths would be reduced by 70%, saving almost 50,000 lives. Educating girls can save millions of lives: If all women had a primary education, there would be 15% fewer child deaths. If all women had a secondary education, child deaths would be cut in half, saving 3 million lives.

Mothers' education improves child nutrition. If all women had a primary education, 1.7 million children would be saved from stunting from malnutrition. If all women had a secondary education, 12 million children would be saved from stunting from malnutrition.

Girls with higher levels of education are less likely to have children at an early age. 10% fewer girls would become pregnant under 17 years in sub-Saharan Africa and South and West Asia if they all had a primary education. Almost 60% fewer girls would become pregnant under 17 years in sub-Saharan Africa and South and West Asia if they all had a secondary education.

Girls with higher levels of education are less likely to get married at an early age. If all girls had a primary education, there would be 14% fewer child marriages. If all girls had a secondary education, there would be two-thirds fewer child marriages.

Education narrows pay gaps between men and women. In Pakistan, women with a primary education earn 51% what men earn. With a secondary education, they earn 70% what men earn. In Jordan, women with a primary education earn 53% what men earn. With a secondary education, they earn 67% what men earn.

Educated women are more likely to find work: In Brazil, only 37% of women with less than primary education are in work. This rises to 50% if they have a primary education, and 60% with a secondary education.
