Adults:

- Listen/ Read (*Lectio*): Ponder God's word and listen for what touches your heart.
- Meditate (*Meditatio*): Attend to what you notice. Allow God's word to resonate in you.
- Speak/Share (*Oratio*): Prayerfully share with Jesus or with the group your thoughts and feelings.
- Rest in God's presence (*Contemplatio*): Notice God's presence and be still, surrounded by God's love.
- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God's nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

Teens:

Virtual Faith Sharing Gatherings



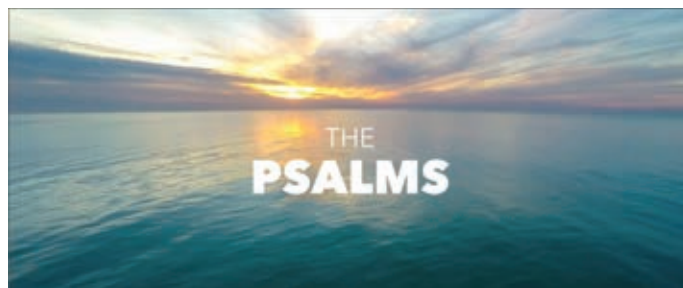

House of Charity Appeal 2020



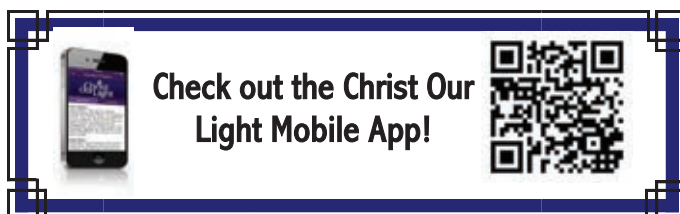
The Second Commandment tells us to "Love your neighbor as yourself", but who is *my Neighbor*?

Donations can now be made to Christ Our Light via TEXT TO GIVE

If you have a Parish Giving Account already set up with your mobile phone number registered, just Text (856) 363-3383 with a dollar sign followed by the amount you would like to donate, for example, \$25. You will get an immediate response confirming your contribution to Christ Our Light. Additionally, you will receive an email when your transaction is processed. The email will be your receipt for the transaction.

If you do not have a Parish Giving account, just Text (856) 363-3383 with a dollar sign followed by the amount you would like to donate, for example, \$25. You will receive a prompt to sign up for an account with the link provided. Once you provide your contact information and either credit/debit card or bank information, along with your email address and phone number you will be all set up. The process takes about 2 minutes! Then you can text a dollar sign followed by the amount you would like to donate and you will receive a response confirming your contribution to Christ Our Light.

\$175.00 1st student
\$ 45.00 each additional student
\$ 45.00 per child for Pre-k/K

- A \$3.00 processing fee is automatically added to your registration.

Casseroles for Joseph's House



Our next delivery of casseroles to Joseph's House of Camden will be Monday morning, May 11, 2020. Thank you so much for your generous donations in April. We were

able to deliver over 30 casseroles, coffee, sugar, creamer, snacks, cookies, cleaning products, toiletries and clothing.

Because there are no scheduled liturgies for the near future, all casseroles and other donations for Joseph's House should be dropped off in the Servers Room in the Ministry Center. The doors will be unlocked. Casseroles can be put in the freezer and other items on the cart. **If you can, please use pans and lids provided** for the casseroles in the lower left cabinet on the church wall behind the Welcome Desk. Mark with date prepared and main ingredients. **Whatever you use, please make sure lids are secure and tight to keep food safe and sanitary.**

In addition to casseroles, the following items are most needed at this time.

- Hand soap, Hand Sanitizer containing at least 60% alcohol (travel size or larger)
- Clorox Wipes, Disinfectant Spray
- Bottled Water
- Sandwiches (cheese and turkey or beef bologna- please use gloves and disinfect surfaces to make these)
- Individually packaged snacks such as cheese and crackers, granola bars, trail mix, etc.
- Coffee, Coffee Creamer – powdered, Sugar

Notes for Nursing Homes



Christ Our Light ministers to five different nursing homes/assisted living facilities in our parish boundaries: Arden Courts, Cherry Hill Senior Living, Avista, Barclay Rehab and

SpringHills. We are all aware of all the restrictions that have been placed on visitations at nursing homes. We would like to reach out to all those in these local facilities with some cards (homemade or purchased).

DO:

Let the people know that you are thinking of them and praying for them

Use at least your first name to sign the card

Identify yourself as a parishioner at Christ Our Light or a member of the Resurrection Catholic School Community (and it would be good to write it out since others may not know what RCS is)

Because these communities represent a wide range of faith traditions, it would be preferable to use God rather than Jesus if you are using a faith reference

Feel free to make cards for the workers in these places. If your card is in an envelope, just make sure it is identified as being for a frontline worker. For those not in envelopes, we will sort those out.

Please return cards to the gathering space by Monday, May 11th. There is a basket on the desk in the gathering space. These will certainly brighten the day of all who receive these cards.

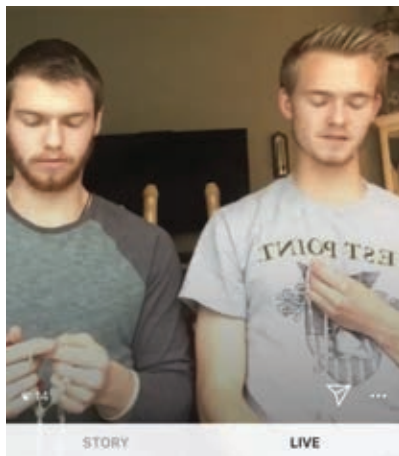
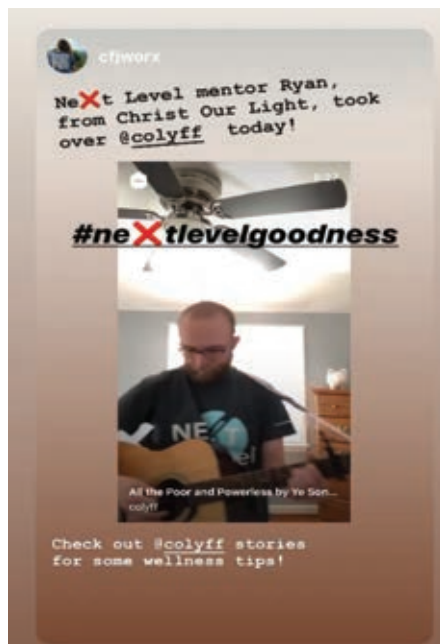

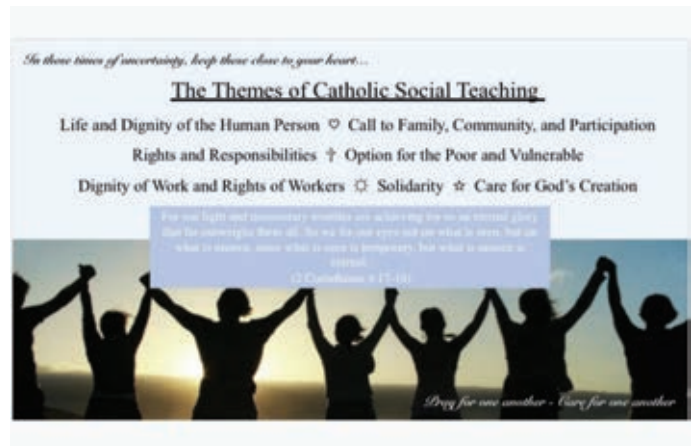
