Reading for May 17, 2020

John 14:15-21

Adults:

How have you noticed the work of the Holy Spirit during these challenging weeks of the pandemic?

We offer this form of *Lectio Divina* (sacred reading) for pondering Scripture and for faith sharing with family members and other people.

- Listen/ Read (*Lectio*): Ponder God's word and listen for what touches your heart.
- Meditate (*Meditatio*): Attend to what you notice. Allow God's word to resonate in you.
- Speak/Share (*Oratio*): Prayerfully share with Jesus or with the group your thoughts and feelings.
- Rest in God's presence (*Contemplatio*): Notice God's presence and be still, surrounded by God's love.
- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God's nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

Teens:

Loving Jesus and following his commandments seems simple to understand; why makes it so complicated and difficult?

Children:

The Holy Spirit is the Spirit of Truth, that little voice inside you telling you what you should and should not do. When have you listened to the voice of the Holy Spirit?

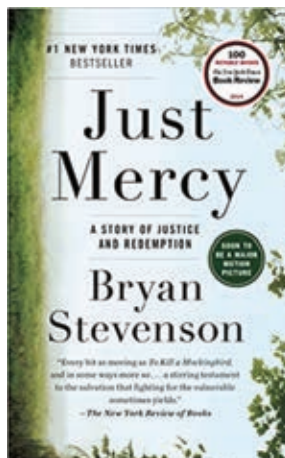

2020 One Book, One Christ Our Light



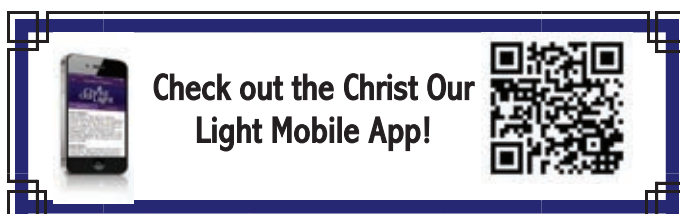

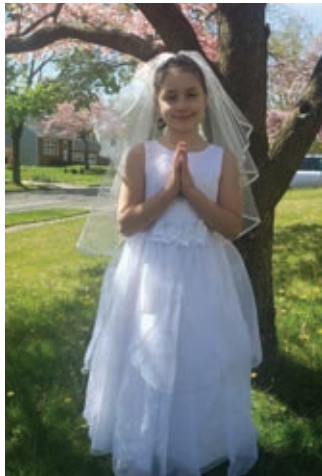

Future First Communion Celebrations!

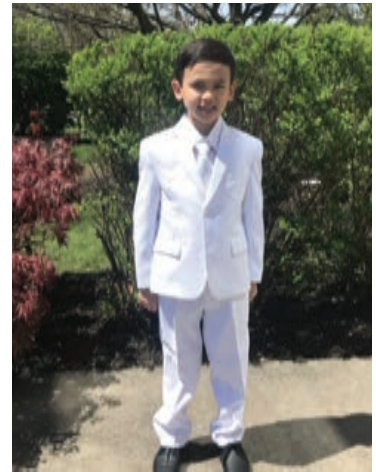

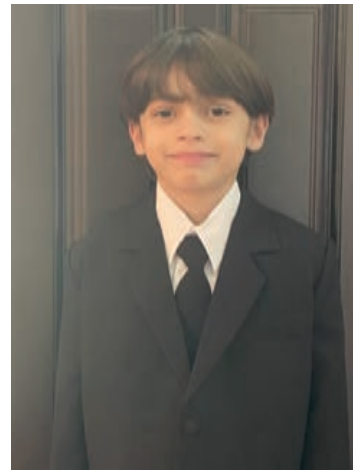

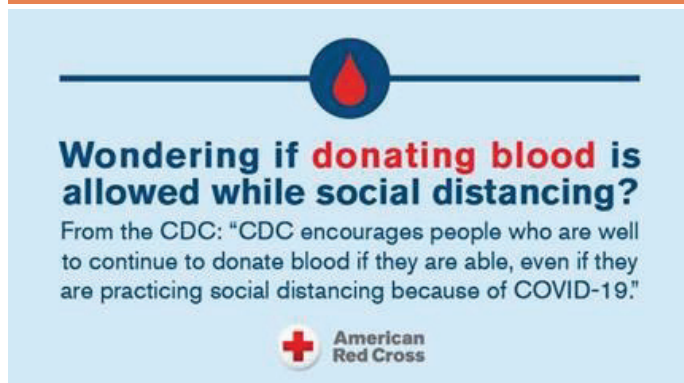
Family Service Opportunities
