- Speak/Share (*Oratio*): Prayerfully share with Jesus or with the group your thoughts and feelings.
- Rest in God's presence (*Contemplatio*): Notice God's presence and be still, surrounded by God's love.
- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God's nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

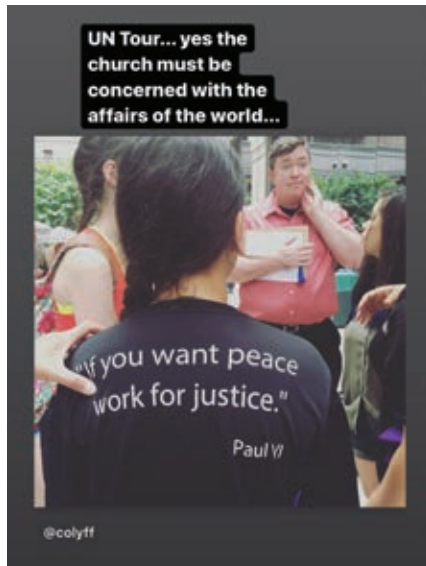
Parish Office Summer Hours

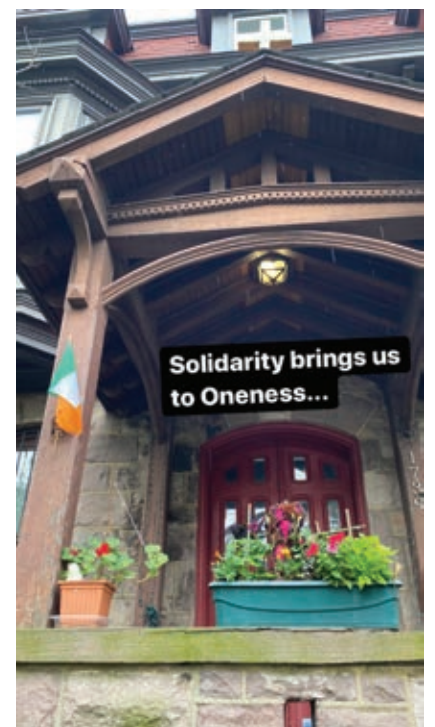

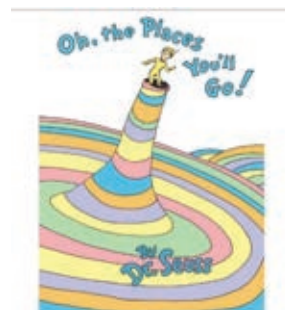

Statement on Racism

To the members of the Christ Our Light community,

We believe that we are in an extremely difficult time in our country's history as we continue to battle a deadly pandemic and the resulting financial and emotional hardship it has brought. At the same time we are trying to come to grips with the long-term effects of racial injustice. Watching tens of thousands of our brothers and sisters take to the streets to speak out against fear and inhumanity is both inspiring for the commitment it represents and heartbreaking for its profound need.

"When will justice come to Athens?" they asked Thucydides. He answered, "Justice will not come to Athens until those who are not injured are as indignant as those who are."

This quote from an ancient Greek philosopher speaks to us today. Solidarity. Solidarity is not just a matter of saying we are with someone. It is a result of a deep listening, sometimes hearing painful things we don't want to hear, things that may want us to become defensive and walk away. But solidarity calls us to walk with others and listen some more. It also calls us to action. As a Catholic community, we had already chosen to take our first steps through Vision 2024 when we offered to take steps "to offer prophetic witness by standing in solidarity with all who suffer discrimination." We further stated that this would be evidenced by "Public advocacy for inclusion within and beyond the parish community." Such is this moment

We stand in solidarity with the members of the black and brown communities who suffer immense fear and harm by systemic societal racism and in particular fear and harm from the members of our society we trust to safeguard and protect us. We stand in solidarity with and support our brothers and sisters who are exercising their constitutional rights to protest against racism and police brutality.

We stand in solidarity because we are all members of the body of Christ and "[If \[one\] part suffers, all the parts suffer with it.](#)" (1 Cor 12: 26)

We stand in solidarity with the good men and women of law enforcement who also decry these killings and violence and suffer shame because of the actions of other officers.

We encourage each member of our community to listen to stories of struggles and pain, pray for a changed world for our youth; work together with civic and church-based movements to assist those who are suffering and living in fear. We encourage each member of our community to search his/her own heart to root out any prejudice we may harbor. Micah 6:8 calls us to act justly, love tenderly and walk humbly with our God. May that path bring us all to peace and a more just society.
