The Word

Reading for July 12, 2020

Matthew 13:1-9

### Adults:

How are you sometimes rocky or thorny soil? How might you become more fertile for God's seeds to take root?

We offer this form of *Lectio Divina* (sacred reading) for pondering Scripture and for faith sharing with family members and other people.

- Listen/ Read (*Lectio*): Ponder God's word and listen for what touches your heart.
- Meditate (*Meditatio*): Attend to what you notice. Allow God's word to resonate in you.
- Speak/Share (*Oratio*): Prayerfully share with Jesus or with the group your thoughts and feelings.
- Rest in God's presence (*Contemplatio*): Notice God's presence and be still, surrounded by God's love.
- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God's nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

### Teens:

What types of seeds might Jesus be trying to plant within you? What might you do better to allow these seeds to grow?

### Children:

Can you remember a time a family member or friend tried to share the seed of a Godly gift with you, such as love, peace, joy, patience, kindness, compassion or forgiveness?

### 2020 One Book, One Christ Our Light



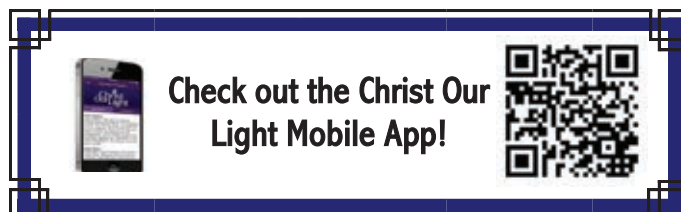

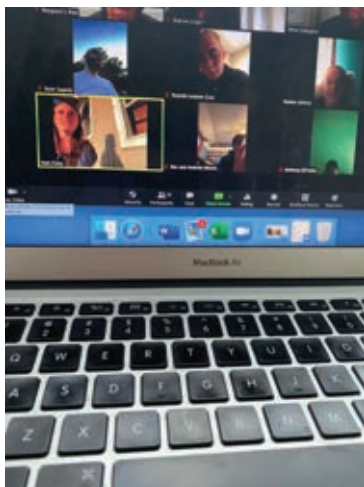
## Youth Ministry

## Justice & Community Outreach

### Joseph's House Casseroles



Our next delivery of casseroles to Joseph's House of Camden will be Monday morning, July 13, 2020. Thank you so much for your generous dona-

tions in May. We were able to deliver 24 casseroles, snacks, breakfast food, sandwiches, cookies, yogurt, coffee, 50+ lbs. of sugar, creamer, bag of new towels, wash cloths, and toiletries.

During the gradual reopening of masses, all casseroles and other donations for Joseph's House should be dropped off in the Servers Room in the Ministry Center. The doors will be unlocked. Casseroles can be put in the freezer and other items on the cart. **If you can, please use pans and lids provided** for the casseroles in the lower left cabinet on the church wall behind the Welcome Desk. Mark with date prepared and main ingredients. **Whatever you use, please make sure lids are secure and tight to keep food safe and sanitary.**

In addition to casseroles, the following items are most needed at this time.

- Hand soap, Hand Sanitizer containing at least 60% alcohol (travel size or larger)
- Clorox Wipes, Disinfectant Spray
- Bottled Water
- Sandwiches (cheese and turkey or beef bologna- please use gloves and disinfect surfaces to make these)
- Individually packaged snacks such as cheese and crackers, granola bars, trail mix, etc.
- Coffee, Coffee Creamer – powdered, Sugar

In these unprecedented times where demand for services has expanded and availability of supplies shrunk, monetary donations are also gratefully accepted and will support JH in the long term.
