Adults:

Greetings from Fr. John Picinic



My dear brothers and sisters of Christ Our Light,

Hello, my name is Father John Paul Picinic. I go simply by, "Fr. John." I know some priests like to be addressed by their last name and that is ok, but I prefer Fr. John. My dad was so proud to name me after St. John the Baptist and he instilled in me the importance of one's name in history and in the Saint for whom you were named and I have always taken that to heart. Once I was ordained I did not want that to change. However, if anyone can guess the nationality of my last name (Picinic) you will win a special gift, do not ask the staff as they already know and don't look it up on Google!

I am happy to begin our journey together. I know it is never easy to undergo change. Fr. Tom has done a wonderful and incredible job as your shepherd over these last 17 years and I know I have big shoes to fill. However, with all the wonderful things I am hearing about the parishioners, lay volunteers and staff I know I will be in good hands.

To share a little about myself, I was born in Astoria, Queen, NY and lived there until I was 9 years old. From NY we moved to Fairview, NJ, yes, unfortunately that is North Jersey, I am sorry. A little town not far away from the George Washington Bridge in Fort Lee. I attended Catholic Grade School in my elementary years and then Cliffside Park High School for my secondary education. From there I began work in the Laborers Union until I was 20 years old. I also worked for 10 years at United Parcel Service in Loss Prevention and somewhere in all of that I began coaching CYO Basketball for six years and then High School Basketball for two years.

I attended The Catholic University of America for my Seminary training acquiring a Bachelors in Religious Education and a Masters in Divinity with some post graduate courses in Systematic Theology and Pastoral Theology.

My first assignment after ordination was at Bishop Eustace Preparatory School (2005-2007). From there I was next assigned to the Catholic Community of the Holy Spirit (2008-2012). I was then transferred to Our Lady of Perpetual Help in Galloway (2012-2014). Bishop Sullivan then appointed me as Pastor of the Church of the Holy Family (2014-2020).

Beyond my parish duties I also serve as an elected member of the Priest Personnel Board, as an elected member of the Diocesan Presbyteral Council, and Chair for the Continuing Education for Priests Committee. In addition to these duties I have also served as an instructor to our Diaconate candidates - instructing them in two courses: Homiletics and Christology.

I am humbled to have been called by Bishop Sullivan to serve as Pastor of Christ Our Light. I ask that you please pray for me as I make this transition and get to know all of you. Know that all of you will be in my prayers. I do want to thank everyone for their kindness to me in your warm welcomes, I look forward to arriving and meeting with you all.

The trailer is open Monday through Thursday. They sell the items and the money goes to support their mission: helping women with crisis pregnancies. Elementary Faith Formation

EFF & YFF Registration



Faith Formation Registration

The Elementary and Youth Faith Formation offices are developing classes for the coming catechetical year. At this time we cannot give you a definite picture of faith formation for 2020-2021 however we have purchased a new curriculum for grades 1-6 from Sadlier Publishing that includes student text-

books as well as online instruction, activities, and a digital parent guide. The "Christ In Us" curriculum is "spiral", meaning that every grade level will experience the same faith lesson, with more in depth content as the years increase. For example: a family with a 3rd grade student and a 5th grade student will both study the same religion lesson geared to their grade and age. This allows parents to assist their children without having to move from subject matter to subject matter.

At this time we are considering home instruction until the first of the year 2021. Each week during this time the children will have a brief Zoom meeting with a catechist to review the previous week's lesson, answer questions, and introduce the new lesson. Parents are then responsible for assisting the children with the content and to oversee assigned homework. More information about this catechetical model will be forthcoming.

Sherine Green and the 7th and 8th grade catechists are structuring a hybrid model of catechesis too. Stay tuned for more information re YFF classes.

PLEASE register your children for classes ASAP. EFF and YFF will happen this year!

Families can register online from the COL website or download, print and complete forms and send to the EFF office with the appropriate fee.

These are challenging times. Maintaining a connection with our Catholic faith and continuing our children's faith formation has never been more important than it is now.

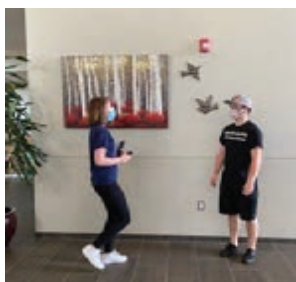
Youth Ministry
