Elementary Faith Formation

EFF & YFF Registration



Faith Formation Registration

The Elementary and Youth Faith Formation offices are developing classes for the coming catechetical year. At this time we cannot give you a definite picture of faith formation for 2020-2021 however we have purchased a new curriculum for grades 1-6 from Sadlier Publishing that includes student text-

books as well as online instruction, activities, and a digital parent guide. The "Christ In Us" curriculum is "spiral", meaning that every grade level will experience the same faith lesson, with more in depth content as the years increase. For example: a family with a 3rd grade student and a 5th grade student will both study the same religion lesson geared to their grade and age. This allows parents to assist their children without having to move from subject matter to subject matter.

At this time we are considering home instruction until the first of the year 2021. Each week during this time the children will have a brief Zoom meeting with a catechist to review the previous week's lesson, answer questions, and introduce the new lesson. Parents are then responsible for assisting the children with the content and to oversee assigned homework. More information about this catechetical model will be forthcoming.

Sherine Green and the 7th and 8th grade catechists are structuring a hybrid model of catechesis too. Stay tuned for more information re YFF classes.

PLEASE register your children for classes ASAP. EFF and YFF will happen this year!

Families can register online from the COL website or download, print and complete forms and send to the EFF office with the appropriate fee.

These are challenging times. Maintaining a connection with our Catholic faith and continuing our children's faith formation has never been more important than it is now.

2 years ago, around this time, we hosted a potluck dinner designed to bring together immigrant & refugee families living in South Jersey with long-time US residents for a night of food, fellowship, and friendship.

Thanks to Catholic Charities, Catholic Relief Services, St. Joseph's Pro-Cathedral, Christ Our Light, MSJC over 140 people attended.

This was glorious! Imagine flags, families, foods, festivities! It was amazing! Attending we had families from Ecuador, Mexico, Guatemala, India, Jamaica, Syria, Iraq, Columbia, Philippines, Dominican Republic, and of course the United States. Our mission team was present as we prepared for Jamaica. This was a good formation experience as we prepared to spend a week at Mustard Seed.

As Catholics, the hope is that we sit together, listen to people (even in the COVID era- safely). Listen more intently to the sufferings of others. It will break us open to new levels of understanding, new vision, greater lens a new periphery. Once our hearts are open the Holy Spirit will do the rest.

For some of my students present at this event, and also adults, this event will forever stay in their hearts as the night shifted stereotypes and preconceptions leaving new experiences of timeless chatter and laughter. As human beings, we are all on a journey! A journey of hope and freedom. The hope is to experience the joy of freedom each time we are renewed by grace.

Our COL Community was granted the grace to sit with people who we do not typically or frequently sit with. The community was able to listen to stories of healing, suffering, and hope. Each of us had a voice at the table which was honored with kindness, compassion, and care. It is this hope that embodies us in the charism of Eucharist.

It is never "us" and "them" for all are journeying together! Make us one Lord. Set us free from the bondage of division which traps our minds. Help us to eradicate superiority from our minds and help us to bring forth the New Kingdom of love and grace.

My takeaways:
