The Word

Reading for September 13, 2020

Matthew 18: 21 - 35

Adults:

How quickly do you forgive? How readily do you seek forgiveness? Consider/ponder the difference between the quantity and the quality of forgiveness.

We offer this form of *Lectio Divina* (sacred reading) for pondering Scripture and for faith sharing with family members and other people.

- Listen/ Read (*Lectio*): Ponder God's word and listen for what touches your heart.
- Meditate (*Meditatio*): Attend to what you notice. Allow God's word to resonate in you.
- Speak/Share (*Oratio*): Prayerfully share with Jesus or with the group your thoughts and feelings.
- Rest in God's presence (*Contemplatio*): Notice God's presence and be still, surrounded by God's love.
- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God's nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

Teens:

When have you shown God's love by forgiving someone? Where do you see an opportunity to give yourself or someone else another chance?

Children:

When have you felt sorry or said "I am sorry" to someone? When have you said "I forgive you" or forgiven someone, even if they did not say they were sorry?

With the gradual reopening of masses, all casseroles and other donations for Joseph's House should be dropped off in the Servers Room in the Ministry Center. The doors will be unlocked. Casseroles can be put in the freezer and other items on the cart. **If you can, please use pans and lids provided** for the casseroles in the lower left cabinet on the church wall behind the Welcome Desk. Mark with date prepared and main ingredients. **Whatever you use, please make sure lids are secure and tight to keep food safe and sanitary.**

In addition to casseroles, the following items are most needed at this time.

- Hand soap, Hand Sanitizer containing at least 60% alcohol (travel size or larger)
- Clorox Wipes, Disinfectant Spray
- Bottled Water
- Sandwiches (cheese and turkey or beef bologna- please use gloves and disinfect surfaces to make these)
- Individually packaged snacks such as cheese and crackers, granola bars, trail mix, etc.
- Coffee, Coffee Creamer – powdered, Sugar
- Socks

EFF & YFF Registration



The Elementary and Youth Faith Formation offices are developing classes for the coming catechetical year. At this time we cannot give you a definite picture of faith formation for 2020-2021 however we have purchased a new curriculum for grades 1-6 from Sadlier Publishing that includes student textbooks as well as online instruction, activities, and a digital parent guide.

At this time we are considering home instruction until the first of the year 2021. Each week during this time the children will have a brief Zoom meeting with a catechist to review the previous week's lesson, answer questions, and introduce the new lesson. Parents are then responsible for assisting the children with the content and to oversee assigned homework. More information about this catechetical model will be forthcoming.

Sherine Green and the 7th and 8th grade catechists are structuring a hybrid model of catechesis too. Stay tuned for more information re YFF classes. PLEASE register your children for classes ASAP. Making a Difference Differently

Yes, we will be holding Mitzvah Day once again, our 11th year of doing so. However, due to the pandemic, Mitzvah Day will look a lot different this year.



The same:

- We will be hosting a blood drive in the school gym.
- We have several sites, mostly outdoors, where we can assure social distancing. So, there will be some opportunities for yard work, food distribution and even some indoor painting
- Donations are being accepted of toiletries, hand bags filled with toiletries, donations for the Animal Welfare Association, warm hats and gloves, prizes for bingo at nursing homes (list to be published)
- And, yes, this is a very short list of opportunities.

Different:

Individuals and families will have the opportunity to pick up supplies and do these projects at home, dropping these off on Mitzvah Day:

- Sandwich making- You can pick up sandwich bags and gloves. You will have to provide your own bread, meat and cheese
- Christmas crafts that we will give to nursing home residents
- Cutlery kits for the Cathedral Kitchen
- Home cooked, frozen meals to support St. Bart's supports seniors
- Clay hearts for Samaritan Hospice
- Fleece blankets and scarves



There will be lots of opportunities for donation drop off:

- Notes and cards to residents in nursing homes
- Homemade cupcakes for the residents at Arden Court
- Baked goods for Ronald McDonald House and Gift of Life
- Knitted and crocheted baby blankets (used for bereavement at Cooper Hospital neo-natal unit)
- Adult backpacks, luggage on wheels (new or used) that can be used by the guests at Joseph's House

Items that are needed prior to Mitzvah Day:

- Gift cards for Joann Fabrics
- Yarn
- Boxes which can be used for transporting sandwiches (the boxes that reams of paper come in are the best)

**The kick off for Mitzvah will be September 12-13.
Paper applications will be available at all the doors and you can also sign up online.**

The following weekend parishioners will have the opportunity to pick up supplies for some of the projects from the parish center. Pick up will be held on Saturday, Sept. 19 from 3pm-6pm and Sunday, Sept. 20 from 8:30 am- 1:00 pm. So, for example, if you or your family would like to make the clay hearts for Samaritan Hospice, you can pick up some of the sculpey clay and directions for the project from the parish center during the hours listed above.

On Mitzvah Day, October 17, we will have stations outside the parish center and school for dropping off the finished projects and food donations.

Mitzvah will look very different this year. What won't be different is the generosity of our parishioners. We are sure of this.

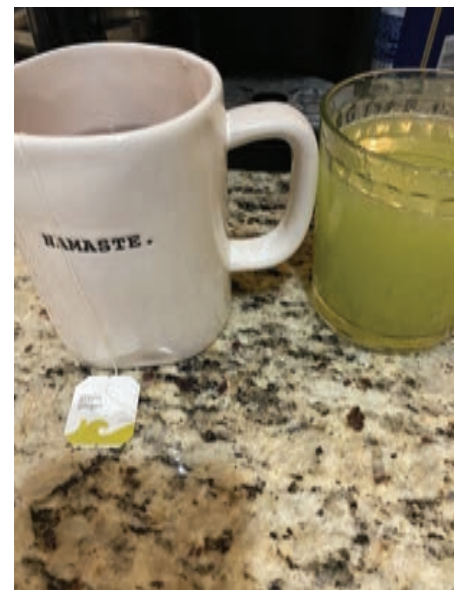
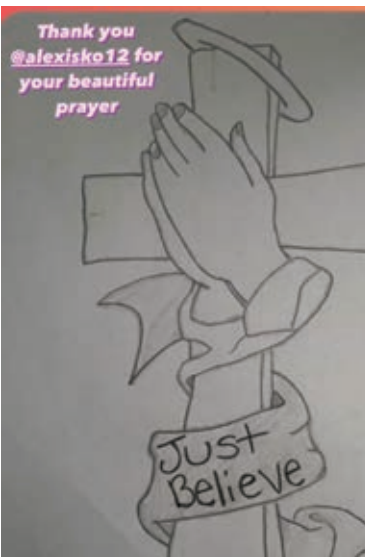
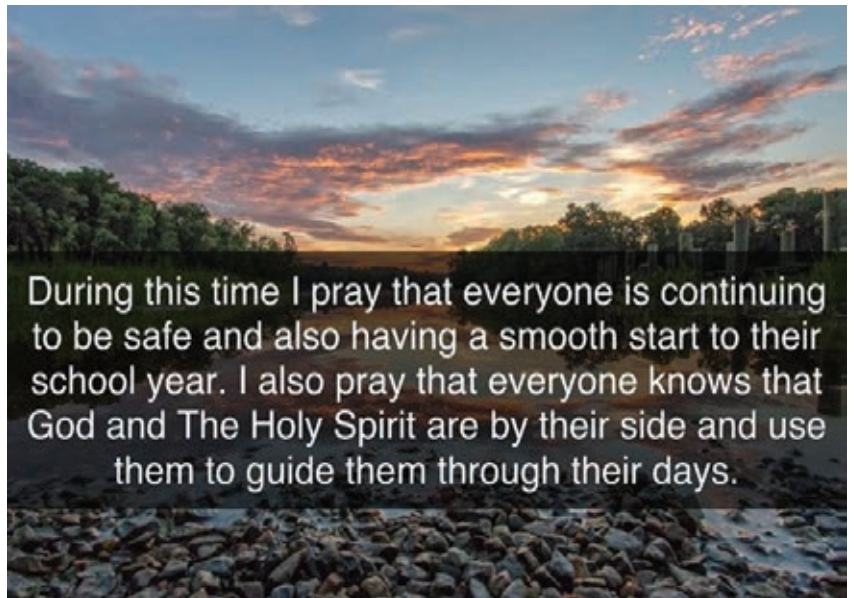
