For those who have lost a child



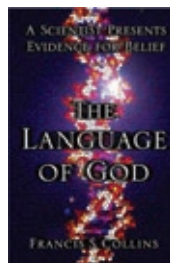

Catholic Strong Campaign Update

My brothers and sisters,

I just wanted to give you an update on where we are with the Catholic Strong Campaign. As of today (October 8th, 2020) we have used approximately \$70,000 dollars to upgrade the Convent's kitchen, laundry room, and carpets. Please see some of the pictures attached below of the good Sisters enjoying these much needed upgrades.

Also, as of today we have a balance of \$377,859 dollars in our Catholic Strong Fund. I want to thank you all so much for your incredible generosity and for your continued love of our parish during this very difficult year.

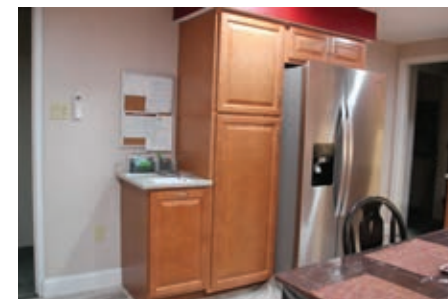
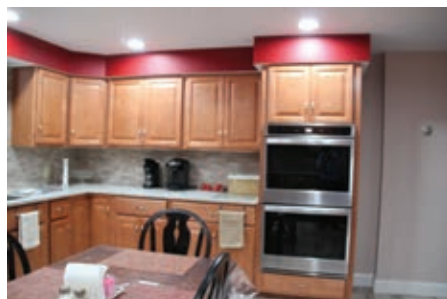
In our last Finance Council Meeting, with the advice and consultation of the trustees and finance council members the following projects were proposed and are in the very early stages of development.

1. A new air-conditioning system for our school. The project will be funded by both the parish Catholic Strong funds 75% and the School's savings fund 25%. Details on this project will be available after we receive all bids and Diocesan approval. Approximate cost \$320,000
2. New air-conditioning and heating upgrades are very much needed in both the rectory and convent as the units are from 1961. The current units are neither environmentally friendly nor efficient to today's standards. Approximate cost \$100,000
3. New bathroom upgrades for the convent and rectory. \$80,000

The Catholic Strong Campaign will come to a close in about two years so we are still receiving our funds each year. We estimate approximately another 100,000 to 150,000 dollars to be collected over that time. The Finance Council will when those funds arrive begin discussions on any upgrades we need in the Church, i.e. a more professional live stream tech upgrade, security upgrades, etc. We will keep you posted and as always please feel free to email me or call me with any questions.

Again, thank you so much for all you do for our parish community. I am moved by your generosity and love. May God continue to bless you and your families.

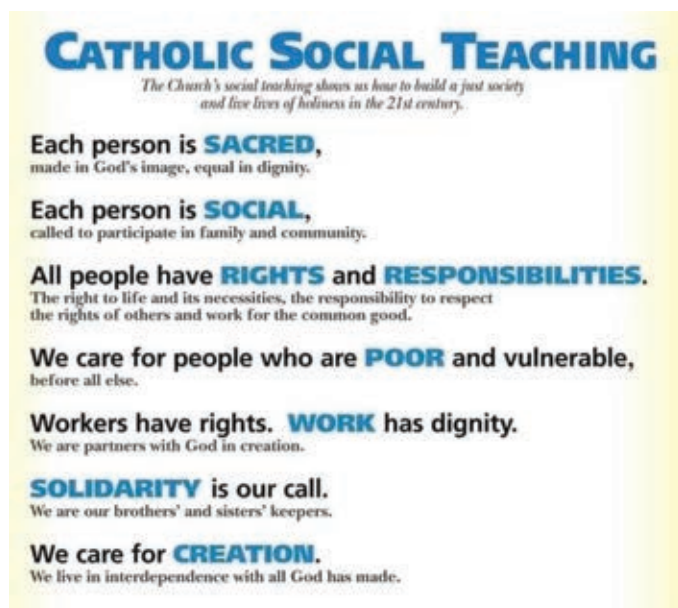
