Year End Charitable Giving



Year-End Charitable Giving via a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD)

If you are looking to lower your taxable income, you may want to consider a QCD. If you are age 70½ or older, IRS rules require you to take required minimum distributions (RMDs) each year from your tax-deferred retirement accounts. This additional taxable income may push you into a higher tax bracket and may also reduce your eligibility for certain tax credits and deductions. To eliminate or reduce the impact of RMD income, charitably inclined investors may want to consider making a qualified charitable distribution (QCD).

A QCD is a direct transfer of funds from an IRA custodian, payable to a qualified charity, as described in the QCD provision in the Internal Revenue Code. Amounts distributed as a QCD can be counted toward satisfying your RMD for the year, up to \$100,000, and can also be excluded from your taxable income. This is not the case with a regular withdrawal from an IRA, even if you use the money to make a charitable contribution later on. In this scenario, the funds would be counted as taxable income even if you later offset that income with the charitable contribution deduction.

Please consult a tax advisor to learn more. If you are 70½ or older, own an IRA, and donate to charity, QCDs may make sense for you; consult a tax advisor regarding your specific situation.

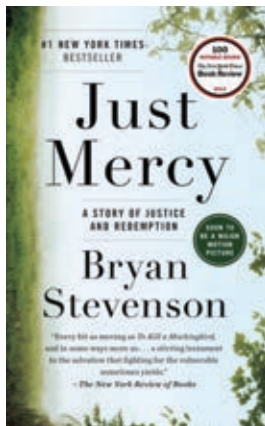

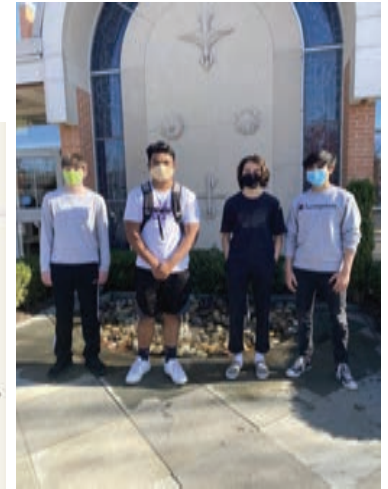

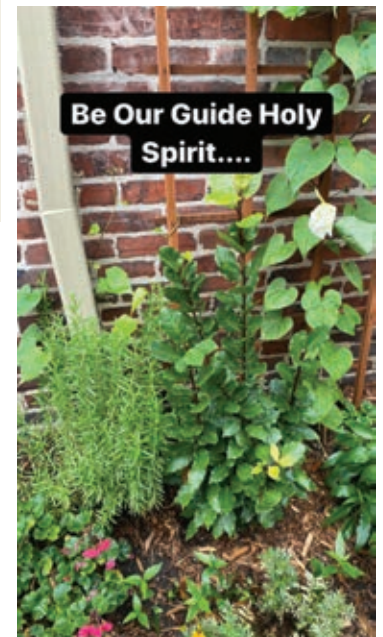

Christmas Adopt-a-Family Program



Christmas may seem a long way off, but we are beginning our remote preparations for our Adopt-a-Family program. For those new to the parish, at Christmas we have several initiatives to help others in need. We have a giving tree which supports families helped through Guadalupe Family Services. We also support women who have elected not to have an abortion through our pro-life ministry. In the past we have also collected gifts for the residents at Barclay Nursing Home, but will be unable to do that this year (at their request) due to covid. At the Christmas Masses, we collect baby items which are donated to Options for Women, First Way in Collingswood and Good Counsel Home. One of the other opportunities we have for giving at Christmas is through our adopt-a-family program. Last year we were able to help 50 families with gifts and gift cards.

There are several ways to be a part of the adopt-a-family program. One way is to volunteer to adopt an entire family. You get to choose the family size that you can support. Some of these families prefer that the donor families shop for them and others prefer getting gift cards so they can shop for their children. Other families help out by not adopting an entire family, but instead, donating gift cards or checks which go into a pool which we use for these families. Part Time - Church Custodian Job Description

We are seeking a proactive, efficient part-time (Weekends) Church Custodian who possesses an understanding of proper cleaning methods.

Duties

- The Church Custodian will ensure that all publicly accessible areas of the church, parish center, and offices are clean and sanitized according to CDC Covid – 19 guidelines, and ready for other staff members and the congregation to use.
- You will make minor repairs, change light bulbs, vacuum, sweep, mop and scrub floors, sanitize surfaces, and restock items, such as toilet paper, paper towels, and other supplies both on a regular basis or as needed.
- You may also maintain supply inventory, submit purchase requests, and assist with preparations for events, such as weddings, baptisms and \ or funerals.
- To be a successful Church Custodian, you should be observant, respectful, motivated, and committed to providing church members, visitors, and staff with a clean, orderly place to worship and congregate. You should also be knowledgeable about proper chemical handling and cleaning techniques and have the ability to make simple and basic repairs, e.g. turning off water of a leaking or clogged sink \ toilet.

Responsibilities:

- Maintaining clean church facilities by performing weekend duties and daily spot cleaning in all public areas of the building, including bathrooms, sanctuary, kitchens, the church, offices, and meeting rooms.
- Working with other maintenance team members and church staff to ensure that all areas are cleaned and stocked with necessary items.
- Observing proper chemical handling procedures when working with cleaning agents, including wearing gloves, goggles, or masks and following written or verbal instructions. To follow CDC sanitizing guidelines in sanitizing all areas.
- Performing simple and light duty maintenance, such as changing light bulbs and restocking bathrooms, and making simple repairs.
- Assisting with event preparations and clean up.
- Taking inventory of cleaners and other supplies and submitting requests when items need to be replenished.
- Interacting with church staff and visitors in a respectful and positive manner.

Church Custodian Requirements:

- High School Diploma or equivalent.
- Custodial experience and \ or training is required.
- Understanding of cleaning techniques, CDC guidelines, and safety procedures.
- Ability to lift up to 50lbs and pass a background check and possible pre-employment drug screening.
- Strong communication, comprehension, and interpersonal skills.
- Flexibility to adjust their schedule to suit the needs of the church.
- Motivation to work independently or with others to provide thorough, efficient custodial services to the church.
