Gaudete Sunday



The Third Sunday in Advent, Gaudete Sunday, is the traditional day when the children of Rome bring their Baby Jesus statues from their home Nativity scenes to be blessed by the Pope. We will join in this tradition known as *Bambinelli* (Baby Jesus) Sunday. All are invited to bring the Baby Jesus figure from your Nativity scene to be blessed at all masses on December 12th & 13th.

Saturday Morning Mass & Reconciliation

Each Saturday morning during Advent, and also on December 26th, morning mass will be celebrated at 9:00 AM, rather than the usual communion service. Following mass, the priest will be available for the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

Year End Charitable Giving



Year End Charitable Giving via a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) - Clarification:

In response to the pandemic, the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act was passed by Congress. Included in this giant relief package was a provision that waives required minimum distributions (RMDs) for 2020 from retirement accounts.

You may be wondering if you can still do a QCD for 2020 even though your RMD is waived. The answer is yes. QCDs can still be made even in years when no RMD is required. QCDs from IRAs are still available in 2020 and still offer tax benefits, even though RMDs are not required.

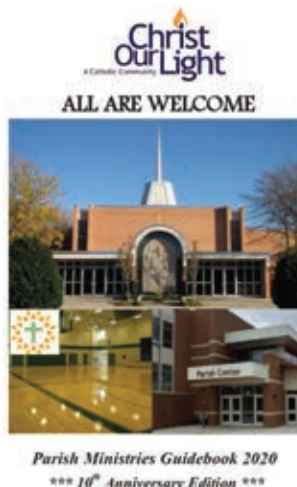
Receive Eucharist Only Opportunity

Christmas Adopt-a-Family Program



Christmas may seem a long way off, but we are beginning our remote preparations for our Adopt-a-Family program. For those new to the parish, at Christmas we have several initiatives to help others in need. We have a giving tree which supports families helped through Guadalupe Family Services. We also support women who have elected not to have an abortion through our pro-life ministry. In the past we have also collected gifts for the residents at Barclay Nursing Home, but will be unable to do that this year (at their request) due to covid. At the Christmas Masses, we collect baby items which are donated to Options for Women, First Way in Collingswood and Good Counsel Home. One of the other opportunities we have for giving at Christmas is through our adopt-a-family program. Last year we were able to help 50 families with gifts and gift cards.

There are several ways to be a part of the adopt-a-family program. One way is to volunteer to adopt an entire family. You get to choose the family size that you can support. Some of these families prefer that the donor families shop for them and others prefer getting gift cards so they can shop for their children. Other families help out by not adopting an entire family, but instead, donating gift cards or checks which go into a pool which we use for these families.
