I would like to thank all of you who participated in our various gifting programs throughout this season. This year we were able to help 58 families through our adopt-a-family program, our largest number ever. We also had the largest numbers of donors ever with 70 households contributing to this effort either by adopting an entire family or by furnishing a check or gift cards which we used to help these families. Your generosity provided some light in some very dark times. One of our gift recipients encouraged us to read his thank you. He wrote in part, "One of the brightest parts of the holidays is people like you. .. Your gift really made the difference between a sad and great Christmas. You didn't have to do it but I am glad and grateful you did. Must feel great to help others in need and I hope to wear your shoes one days and be the one to help others." A great addition to the adopt-a-family program was BookSmiles donating hundreds of Christmas books for children of different ages. These were a huge hit. Parents and grandparents spent time at the table sorting through the books their children and grandchildren would enjoy. A special thank you to Mary DelRossi and Nancy Bradis in our office without whom the adopt-a-family program would be impossible. Thanks to parishioner Kathy Judge for coordinating the BookSmiles donation.

Thank you, too, to all those who supported Guadalupe Family Services through our giving tree. Sr. Helen Cole wrote: "A special thank you to the parishioners of Christ our Light for their overwhelming generosity of gifts to our Christmas gift giving program! In the midst of this stressful time, you have brought delight and relief to our families in need. May God continue to bless you for your thoughtfulness." Thanks, too, to those who contributed gift cards for our Respect Life ministry. Thank you to Jeanne Bracy, Maureen Cahill, Michelle Tartamosa, and Ann Parsons for overseeing the Giving Tree this year.

Another wonderful gift was a donation we received for our food program. One of our parishioners is on a board which would match donations used for food programs. With her donation of \$5000, we received a total of \$10,000 to help feed people. We are spreading its use over two years, but part of the funds this year went to make sure every family helped in our adopt-a-family program had a gift card to a food store so they could have a good family feast on Christmas Day. We've received additional donations of \$500 and \$50 as well as some ongoing donations to help out our food pantry. All of these are much appreciated. We had the added gift of a women's group from Moorestown (led by a parishioner) who for the second year in a row donated gift cards to Acme instead of doing a gift exchange. So in addition to the boxed and canned food from our food pantry, we will be able to give out some gift cards so people can buy fresh food as well.

Thanks, too, to all those who donated baby gifts at Christmas masses. These gifts will go to Good Counsel Home in Riverside, Options for Women and First Way. All of these gifts are so very much appreciated. As usual, the response was overwhelming.

This Christmas was unusual in many ways for all of us. What was not different was the generous outpouring from our parishioners.
