What Is a Stephen Minister?

Stephen Ministers are laypeople—Christian men and women—trained to provide one-to-one care to people experiencing a difficult time in life. We have many needs for care in our parishes and our communities. People experience divorce, grief, terminal illness, loss of job, relocation, empty nest, retirement, aging, hospitalization, loneliness, and many other stresses and challenges especially in our current situation. Often people with needs suffer silently or do not request or receive the level of care they really need. With only one or two priests

for a large parish, you can quickly see why it would be impossible for our priests to meet every single need of every single person. Stephen Ministry expands the care the parish can offer by equipping and organizing members to provide Christian care. This gives us a larger pool of people with the gifts, skills and calling, to bring Christ's love and care to those who need it.

Stephen Ministers come from all walks of life. Their commonality? A passion for bringing Christ's love and care to people during a time of need. Stephen Ministry is based on the idea that all Christians are called to minister to others. The responsibility for passing on God's love is for all Christians, not just for a chosen few. God has given us all gifts for ministry and called us to put those gifts to use. Stephen Ministry is a way people with special gifts for caring ministry can use those gifts to bring Christ's love to people in need.

Everybody benefits from Stephen Ministry. Those receiving care from Stephen Ministers benefit because they receive prayer and support throughout the crisis they face. Stephen Ministers benefit through the spiritual growth they experience from being involved in meaningful ministry. Priests benefit because caring ministry at our parishes is expanded, and fewer people will slip through the cracks. Most of all you benefit from the knowledge that special care is available to you should you need it. In addition, you now have a place where you can refer a friend, neighbor, coworker, relative, or anyone else you know who is going through a difficult time so that they can receive special care when they need it most. Stephen Ministry makes our parish a much more caring place!

Since 1975, more than 600,000 people from more than 11,000 congregations and other organizations have been trained as Stephen Ministers. We have five commissioned Stephen Ministers in our parish. Christ Our Light is inviting parishioners to consider this ministry.

Stephen Ministers commit to 50 hours of training and peer supervision each month once their training is completed. We will be beginning a new class for Stephen Ministers in early spring. The 50 hours of training consists of 20 modules of 2 ½ hours each on such topics as feelings, listening, Christian caring, boundary setting, confidentiality, referrals to mental health professionals, grief, depression, recognizing suicidal thinking, and supervision.

Christ Our Light currently has 5 Stephen Ministers and a referrals coordinator on our Stephen Ministry team. We are hoping to begin a training class for new Stephen Ministers in early spring. Because of covid, the training will be done via zoom.
