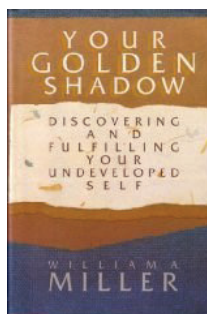

Boy Scout Troop 70



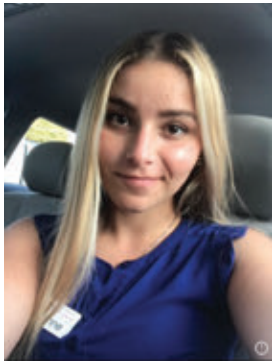
"A Scout is Reverent"

Cherry Hill Food Pantry Collection



We will be holding one of our periodic collections for the Cherry Hill Food Pantry the weekend of February 13-14. The items that they are requesting are shampoo, deodorant, napkins and detergent.

Last year the food pantry distributed nearly one million pounds of food (946,293 pounds). In the course of 2020, they served 1980 families with 1190 adults, 1258 children and 298 seniors. Outstanding work in a time of outstanding need.

One of the most pressing needs of the Cherry Hill Food Pantry at this time is donations to help fund their renovations at the new facility at 910 Beechwood Ave. in Cherry Hill. The hope is that with these renovations and the end of the pandemic, they will be able to return to their former model of letting clients choose their own food off a shelves rather than receiving already packed bags.

Because of this unique time in the pantry history, we are inviting people to give cash donations instead of supplying the items requested at the beginning of this article. We will have envelopes for these donations at all the church doors beginning the weekend of January 30-31. These envelopes can be deposited in the regular collection basket. Black History Month

Sister Thea Bowman

In honor of Black History Month, each Sunday of February, the Unity Rich in Diversity Focus Group of the Pastoral Council will feature one Black Servant of God, Venerable, Blessed, or Saint. This week we are drawing your attention to Servant of God Sister Thea Bowman, FSPA, who is in the first stage of the canonization process. The banner placed in the church picturing Sister Thea was borrowed from the Black Catholic Ministry of the Camden Diocese. A part of Servant of God Sister Thea Bowman's story follows.

Sister Thea Bowman was born Bertha Elizabeth, in Yazoo, Mississippi, in 1937 to loving and well-educated parents. Bertha's mother Mary Esther was a teacher and her father Theon was a physician who practiced medicine in Yazoo and then in Canton, where the Bowman family settled and where both Mary Esther and Theon died in 1984. Her family home was where Sister Thea chose to live her final days prior her death in 1990.

When the Franciscan Sisters of Perpetual Adoration went to Canton, Mississippi, to teach, they were models of Christ-like living and loving. So inspired, at the young age of nine, Bertha became a Catholic. Encouraged by their daughter's strong conviction and powerful witness, Bertha's parents eventually became Catholic.

Equally startling as their daughter's conversion was Bertha's desire to leave Canton and go to St. Rose High School in Wisconsin at the age of 15 with the intention to join the Franciscan Sisters of Perpetual Adoration. Four years later in August of 1956, Bertha became Sister Thea, FSPA, the order's first Black member. Sister Thea loved learning and she excelled in academics. She earned a bachelor degree in arts from Viterbo College and both a master of arts degree and a Ph.D. in English literature from Catholic University of America.

Through her ministry, Thea taught, sang spirituals, and travelled, giving presentations and workshops with a mission to bring an awareness of Black spirituality to her Catholic Church. Sister Thea taught for sixteen years at the elementary, secondary, and college level. She helped form committees to help the Church to reach out to include and to minister to the Black community so that they would feel truly participating members of the Body of Christ. Sister Thea believed that the best way to be truly Catholic is for the Church to be fully integrated with many cultures so that we may all benefit from the richness of each culture and the blending of all cultures.

One of the highlights of Sister Thea's ministry was an invitation to speak to the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops in 1989 at Seton Hall University. To the question, "What does it mean to be Black in the Church and society?" Sister Thea revealed her experience through singing the song, "Sometimes I Feel Like a Motherless Child." She captured the attention of her audience and at times tears could be seen in the eyes of the bishops. She was weak with cancer that had reached her bones. Still she endured the pain and the uncertainty as to whether she could finish her mission that day. Yet, her voice was strong and brought home her message with conviction, strength, and love to the bishops as her brothers in the family of the Church.

The old film is a little fuzzy, but it remains powerful and it is inspiring to watch Sister Thea Bowman in action. The film runs for about 40 minutes.

Sister Thea unearthed the roots of her Black culture, created awareness of its spirituality, its music and its expression, and she planted it firmly in the experience and in the hearts of those whose lives she touched.

If you are interested in further reading, Brother Michael O'Neill McGrath, OSFS, of our diocese has written and illustrated a lovely book titled, *This Little Light, Lessons in Living from Sister Thea Bowman*.
