- Speak/Share (*Oratio*): Prayerfully share with Jesus or with the group your thoughts and feelings.
- Rest in God's presence (*Contemplatio*): Notice God's presence and be still, surrounded by God's love.
- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God's nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

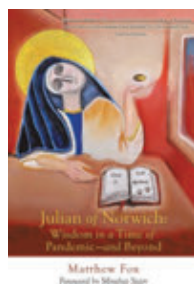
Ever Ancient, Ever New

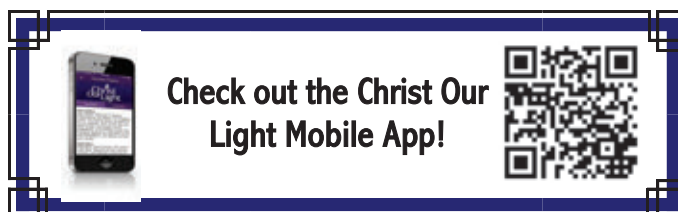

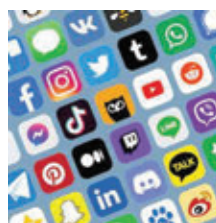

Dear Parishioners,

We thank you with much appreciation for your continuous support of the Cherry Hill

Food Pantry. Your generosity has made it possible to continue our mission of providing food assistance to needy families and individuals in Cherry Hill and the surrounding communities of Haddonfield, Marlton and Mt. Laurel.

If you or someone you know is in need and lives in one of those towns, you or they, can register at the pantry on Tuesdays from 6:00 PM until 7:30 PM or Thursdays from 11:00 AM until 1:00 PM and receive non perishables as well as produce, meat, bread, dairy and desserts monthly. Please note that members of our congregation who do not live in those towns are also eligible to receive food at the pantry. For those individuals, a letter from the pastor verifying that they are members of the congregation is required.

In addition, in response to the Pandemic, the Pantry is providing food assistance every Wednesday evening from 5:00 PM until 6:30 PM to all other New Jersey residents not eligible as described above. A New Jersey photo ID is required. We notify you of this extra client assistance so you may refer those additional New Jersey residents you know to be in need to our Wednesday evening sessions.
