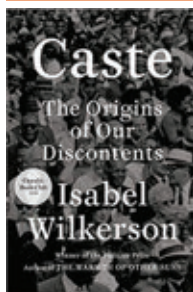


Christ Our Light is seeking to fill a part-time position in the Parish Office. Under the direct supervision of the Pastor, the Ministry Associate provides administrative

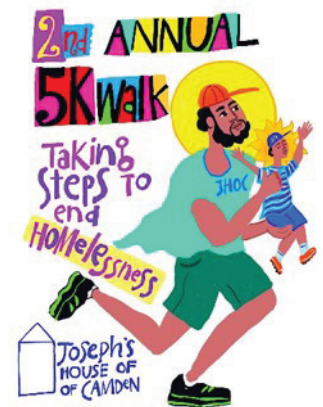
Joseph's House 2nd Annual 5k

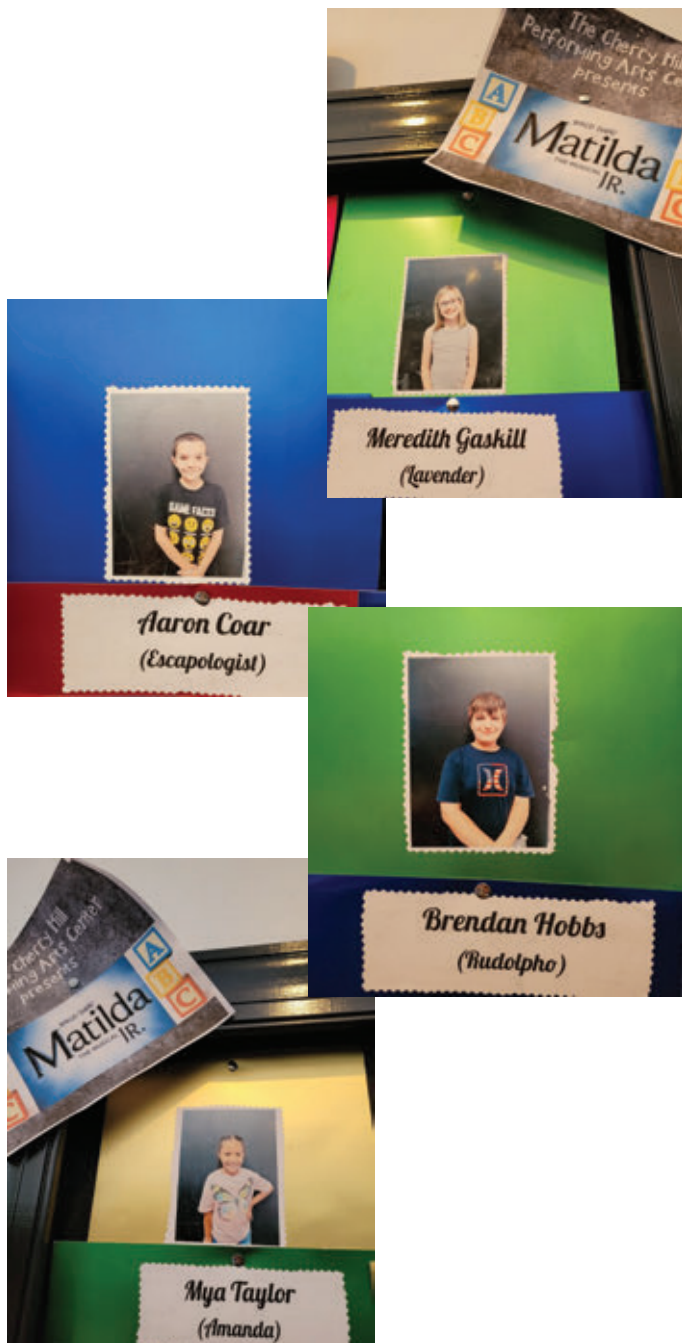

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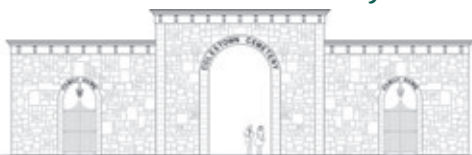
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
