Adults:

- Listen/ Read (*Lectio*): Ponder God's word and listen for what touches your heart.
- Meditate (*Meditatio*): Attend to what you notice. Allow God's word to resonate in you.
- Speak/Share (*Oratio*): Prayerfully share with Jesus or with the group your thoughts and feelings.
- Rest in God's presence (*Contemplatio*): Notice God's presence and be still, surrounded by God's love.
- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God's nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

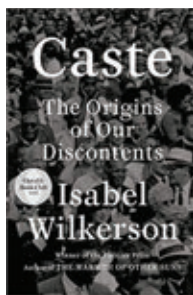

FAITH FORMATION REGISTRATION

The Elementary Faith Formation office is accepting registrations for students grade Pre-K through 8 for the catechetical year beginning September 2021. Families whose children currently attend weekly classes at COL have received re-registration materials.. Children are eligible to prepare for and celebrate the sacraments of 1st Reconciliation and 1st Eucharist only if they have successfully completed a full year of EFF. With that in mind parents / guardians are encouraged to begin a child's Elementary Faith Formation upon entering 1st grade.

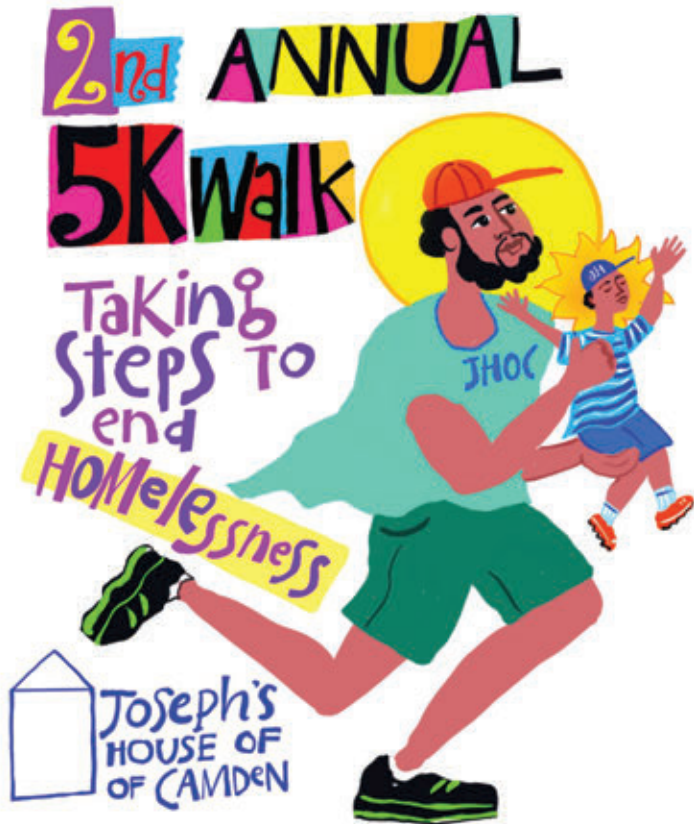

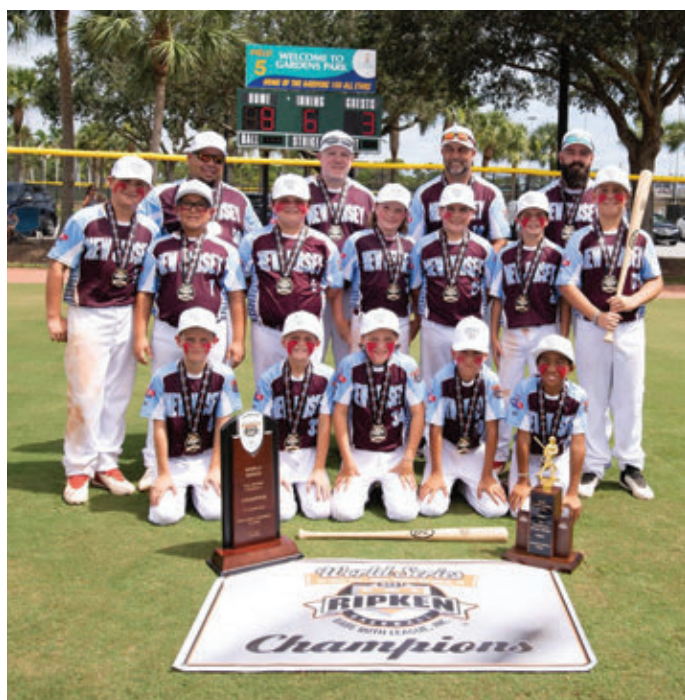
