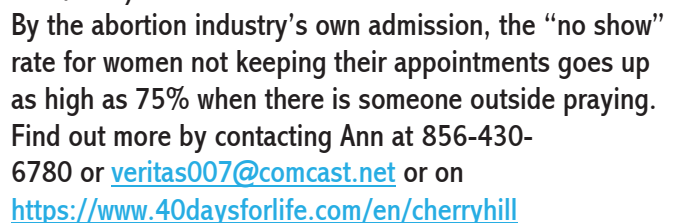

- As one child said, "CLOW helps me understand; I don't understand all those big words."

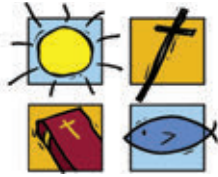

Every Saturday at 9:00 AM there is a Mass instead of the previously held Communion Service.

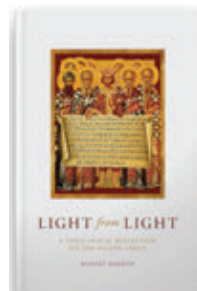
Wednesday Holy Hour Adoration

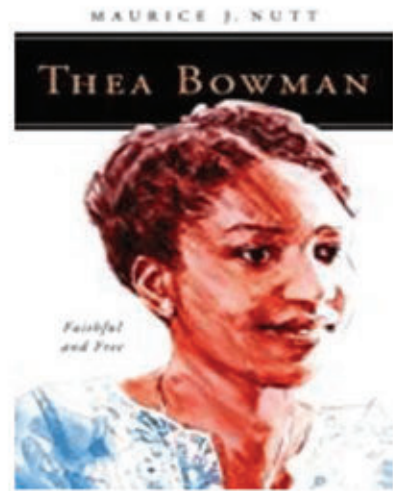

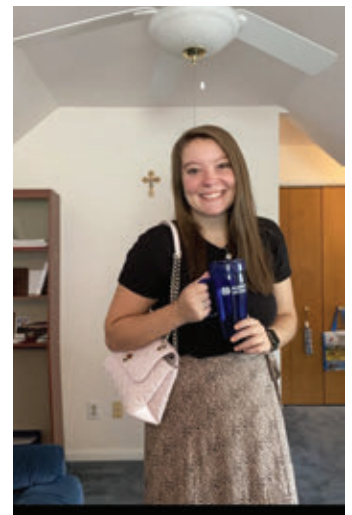
