Reading for October 3, 2021

Mark 10: 2-16

Adults:

How does “hardness of heart” make it difficult to maintain relationships?

We offer this form of *Lectio Divina* (sacred reading) for pondering Scripture and for faith sharing with family members and other people.

- Listen/ Read (*Lectio*): Ponder God’s word and listen for what touches your heart.
- Meditate (*Meditatio*): Attend to what you notice. Allow God’s word to resonate in you.
- Speak/Share (*Oratio*): Prayerfully share with Jesus or with the group your thoughts and feelings.
- Rest in God’s presence (*Contemplatio*): Notice God’s presence and be still, surrounded by God’s love.
- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God’s nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

Children's Liturgy of the Word (CLOW) will resume in mid-September and continues through May at the 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. Masses.

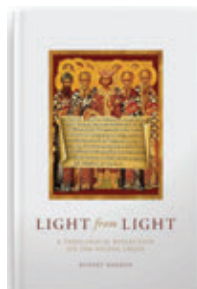


VOLUNTEERS ARE NEEDED

- As one child said, "CLOW helps me understand; I don't understand all those big words."

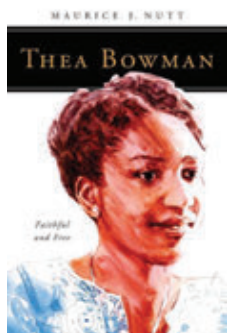
