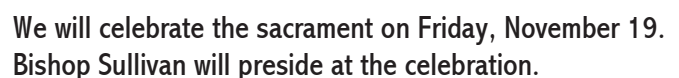

Children's Liturgy of the Word (CLOW) will resume in mid-September and continues through May at the 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. Masses.

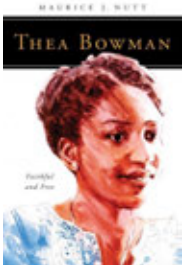


VOLUNTEERS ARE NEEDED

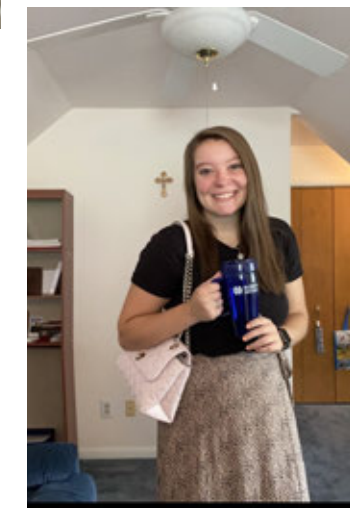
