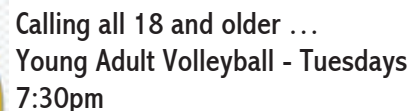

Sr. Thea encourages us to be open to the joy and truth that God brings to our lives, no matter our circumstances:

The old folks never wondered if Jonah was real or if the whale was real. They knew the Johan story was eternal truth—truth that no man or woman or little child can hide from the power of the all-seeing, all-knowing, all powerful God. “you can run but you can’t hide.” Truth—that God will save and deliver. “Didn’t my Lord deliver Jonah from the belly of the whale?” Truth - that happiness can be found only in following God’s all perfect Will: “In God’s Will is our peace.”
