- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God’s nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

Cherry Hill Food Pantry Collection



Last year the food pantry distributed nearly one million pounds of food (946,293 pounds). In the course of 2020, they served 1980 families with 1190 adults, 1258 children and 298 seniors. Outstanding work in a time of outstanding need.

One of the most pressing needs of the Cherry Hill Food Pantry at this time is donations to help fund their renovations at the new facility at 910 Beechwood Ave. in Cherry Hill. Their biggest need is for a new parking lot. The hope is that with these renovations and the end of the pandemic, they will be able to return to their former model of letting clients choose their own food off the shelves rather than receiving already packed bags.

Because of this unique time in the pantry history, we are inviting people to give cash donations instead of supplying items. We will have envelopes for these donations at all the church doors the weekend of October 30-31.

There will be a special collection basket near the regular collection basket the weekend of November 6-7. Please make checks out to Cherry Hill Food Pantry (CHFP). If you would like to mail a donation directly to the pantry the mailing address is P.O. Box 8465 Cherry Hill, NJ 08002.

SSJ Neighborhood Center



Thank you to all who contributed to the food collection for the SSJ Neighborhood Center. Prior to our collection, their shelves were pretty bare. They served 215 families on their distribution day. They have found out that 2 or 3 other food pantries in their area have closed so they are experiencing an uptick in need. Our next collection for the center will be the weekend of November 13-14. The most needed donation items are pasta and sauce, small bags of white rice (5 pounds and under), and red, white or black beans. Please put your donations in the hallway to the right of the gathering space that weekend.

Mark with date prepared and main ingredients. **Make sure lids are secure and tight to keep the food safe and sanitary.**
