- Listen/ Read (*Lectio*): Ponder God's word and listen for what touches your heart.
- Meditate (*Meditatio*): Attend to what you notice. Allow God's word to resonate in you.
- Speak/Share (*Oratio*): Prayerfully share with Jesus or with the group your thoughts and feelings.
- Rest in God's presence (*Contemplatio*): Notice God's presence and be still, surrounded by God's love.
- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God's nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

Celebration of Youth and Young Adults on the Solemnity of Christ the King



This weekend, the Church celebrates youth and young adults in a special way on the Solemnity of Jesus Christ, King of the Universe. Pope John Paul II originally instituted this celebration on Palm Sunday 1985, acknowledging that it was young people who first recognized Jesus as a king as he rode into Jerusalem before his Passion (cf. Mt 21:15-16). In 2020, Pope Francis moved the celebration to Christ the King Sunday, seeing the connection between young people as the initial proclaimers of Christ's kingship and Christ's final and unending rule over all when he comes again. Pope Francis writes in *Christus Vivit*, "the community has an important role in the accompaniment of young people; it should feel collectively responsible for accepting, motivating, encouraging, and challenging them" (CV 243). May we be especially attentive to our young people as they journey through life, helping them to grow closer and closer to Jesus Christ, King of the Universe.

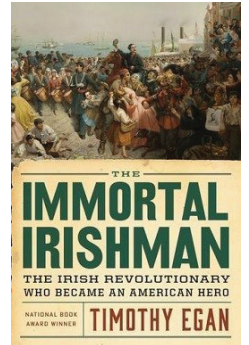

Adopt-a-Family Program



Christmas may seem a long way off, but we are beginning our remote preparations for our Adopt-a-Family program. For those new to the parish, at Christmas we have several initiatives to help others in need. We have a giving tree which supports families helped through Guadalupe Family Services. We also support women who have elected not to have an abortion through our pro-life ministry. In the past we have also collected gifts for the residents at Barclay Nursing Home, but will be unable to do that this year (at their request) due to covid. At the Christmas Masses, we collect baby items which are donated to Options for Women, First Way in Collingswood and Good Counsel Home. One of the other opportunities we have for giving at Christmas is through our adopt-a-family program. Last year we were able to help 50 families with gifts and gift cards.

There are several ways to be a part of the adopt-a-family program. One way is to volunteer to adopt an entire family. You get to choose the family size that you can support. Some of these families prefer that the donor families shop for them and others prefer getting gift cards so they can shop for their children. Other families help out by not adopting an entire family, but instead, donating gift cards or checks which go into a pool which we use for these families. Grief Recovery Program



Do you have a broken heart? Do you feel lost or stuck after a grief experience, either recent or from long ago?

The Grief Recovery Method® may be able to help. **Come to an information session on Saturday, December 11, at 10:30 AM in the St. Francis Room of the parish center** and learn a new way to think about grief and about the specific tools to help you recover from loss and ultimately lead a happier life. This is an educational program, not a support group. The 8-week series of classes will be offered starting in early January. Presented by Marie Mitarotondo, Advanced Grief Recovery Specialist™, certified by the Grief Recovery Institute. 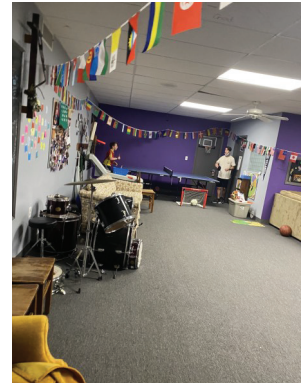
