Celebrating Mass daily during the nine days before Christmas is a wonderful spiritual preparation for the Christmas season. Please join us, even for just a day or two.

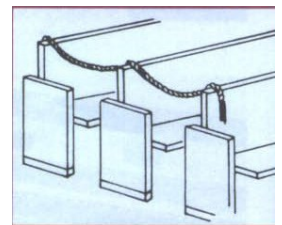
Gaudete Sunday

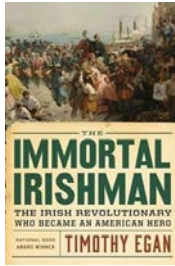

Adopt-a-Family Program



Christmas may seem a long way off, but we are beginning our remote preparations for our Adopt-a-Family program. For those new to the parish, at Christmas we have several initiatives to help others in need. We have a giving tree which supports families helped through Guadalupe Family Services. We also support women who have elected not to have an abortion through our pro-life ministry. In the past we have also collected gifts for the residents at Barclay Nursing Home, but will be unable to do that this year (at their request) due to covid. At the Christmas Masses, we collect baby items which are donated to Options for Women, First Way in Collingswood and Good Counsel Home. One of the other opportunities we have for giving at Christmas is through our adopt-a-family program. Last year we were able to help 50 families with gifts and gift cards.

There are several ways to be a part of the adopt-a-family program. One way is to volunteer to adopt an entire family. You get to choose the family size that you can support. Some of these families prefer that the donor families shop for them and others prefer getting gift cards so they can shop for their children. Other families help out by not adopting an entire family, but instead, donating gift cards or checks which go into a pool which we use for these families. 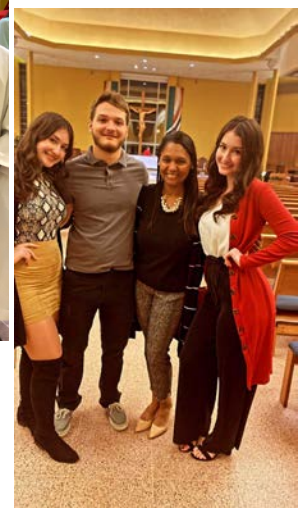
Confirmation Reflection

As the time for confirmation lurks around the corner, it is time to sum up all I have experienced in my confirmation journal. As I have gotten older, my definition of service has changed along with my faith in the last year or two. Confirmation preparation is a major reason why.

Before Covid, I never really connected service with God. Service to me was just something a good person would do, and Catholicism was just being a good person. This all shifted in quarantine, where the world was plagued with uncertainty. Being locked in for a couple months made me appreciate what I have more. Mainly it taught me to appreciate family time, but it made me grateful for a home and a cozy bed to sleep in at night. In all of the chaos and pain in the world, I turned to God for more than I had before. I found myself praying nightly, and even reading the bible whenever I was anxious about whatever was on the news that night. Coming out of my house and into 8th grade I felt more close to God than I had ever before. I was able to carry that faith through 8th grade. I was aware that confirmation was now approaching, and I was excited to put in the required hours. But that is where I was surprised: there were no required hours. This gave me a choice. These choices were to either put in light hours and think nothing of it, or focus more on the quality of service being done. Truth be told, option A seemed much easier and was very tempting. But then a little school called St. Joseph's prep came along.

At St. Joseph's prep, they had three things they emphasized along with education. Giving back, giving back, and giving back. The school is all about giving back to the city they belong to. Since service was such a big part of The Prep experience, there were opportunities right away. The first service activity I did was cleaning up a nearby neighborhood. There I would find a "Dangerous neighborhood" that is actually filled with genuine, kind people. The appreciative smiles of the residents made me try to make the most of the service opportunity. The next activity I did was I went to the Gesu Elementary school next to The Prep. There I was asked to help a kindergarten class make turtles from paper plates. While it was not exactly exciting or hard work, the joy on the kids' faces as you glue googly eyes onto construction paper makes it feel like you did so much more. These acts of service probably totaled three hours, maybe less. But it felt like I had done much more. This made me realize the quality of service tops quantity. I feel like service can be as small as smiling at somebody, service is just bringing someone joy. Whether that be cleaning shattered bottles of alcohol on the street, or giving little Emry a high five for cutting a triangle correctly. So as confirmation approaches, I realize that I can serve God every day just by connecting with people and bringing them joy. I want to bring people joy for more than just confirmation, I want to pursue it in life because it is so rewarding. I look forward to essentially committing to the church where I can mirror what God encourages us to do as Catholics and his children.

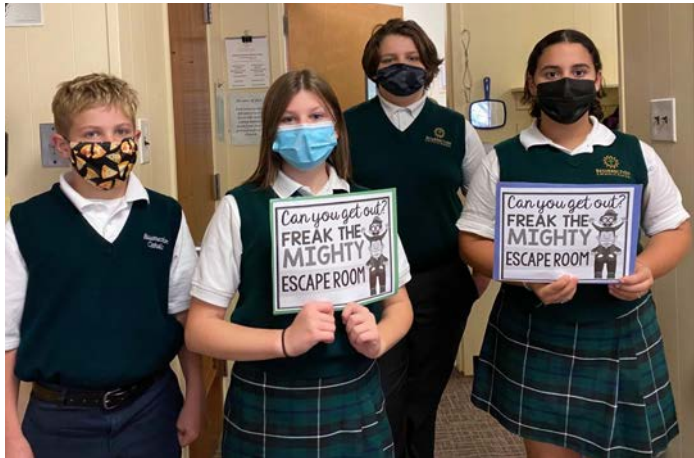
