Reading for December 19, 2021

Micah 5:1-4a

Adults:

How have you powerfully experienced God's presence in the little moments of life and how has this impacted you?

We offer this form of *Lectio Divina* (sacred reading) for pondering Scripture and for faith sharing with family members and other people.

- Listen/ Read (*Lectio*): Ponder God's word and listen for what touches your heart.
- Meditate (*Meditatio*): Attend to what you notice. Allow God's word to resonate in you.
- Speak/Share (*Oratio*): Prayerfully share with Jesus or with the group your thoughts and feelings.
- Rest in God's presence (*Contemplatio*): Notice God's presence and be still, surrounded by God's love.
- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God's nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

Teens:

How does the phrase, "good things come from small packages" apply to this Scripture passage as well as to your own life?

Children:

How would you like to help people when you grow up?

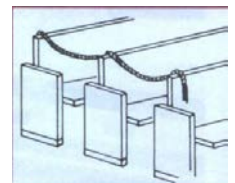

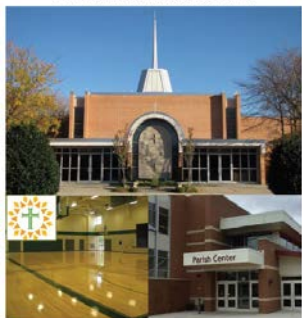

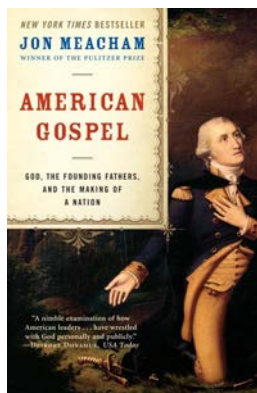
Guide Book & Directory Advertising Opportunity

Gift suggestions:

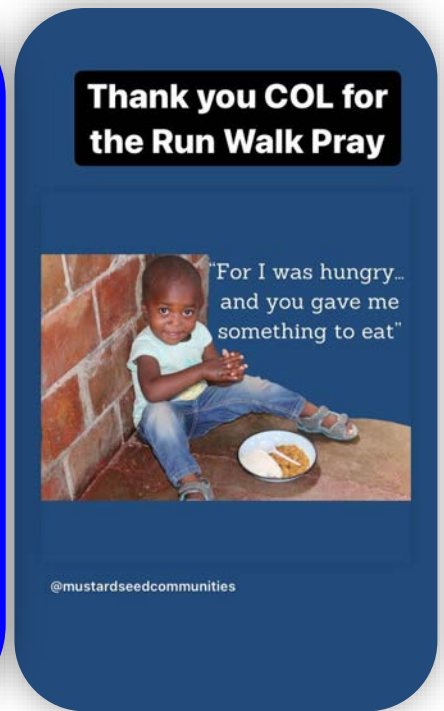
- Diapers and wipes (most needed and in any size)
