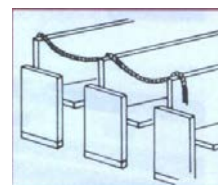

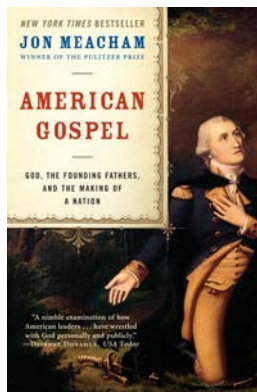

Answer to Prayer

This Christmas season has led to many reflections for me, but the one which keeps recurring is “the answer to prayers.” I think about the people who call or come to us for help. Their prayer-spoken or unspoken- might be that they do not have to spend the night sleeping in their car, that they have enough food for themselves and their children, that they can get help so the electric doesn’t get turned off, that their families are safe and secure. And because of who we are as a parish, because of living out our baptism, we are sometimes the answer to their prayers.

I think about our homebound parishioners, people in nursing homes and assisted living facilities praying for a meaningful visit, the chance to receive sacraments, and because of the commitment of a team of people, we are an answer to their prayers as parishioners and clergy conduct prayer services, pray with people, bring communion to them and spend time visiting. I think of the many people who made and wrote cards to these same people for Mitzvah Day.

I think of all those who find themselves struggling to provide for their families. Christmas is especially hard. And YOU are the answer to their prayers. We distributed almost 400 tags through our Giving Tree and those presents bring great joy to parents who will be able to provide gifts for their children. I think about our Adopt-a-Family program. Through the generosity of many parishioners we were able to help over 55 families which includes over 200 children and grandchildren. Through the generosity of these same donors, we were able to help a mother of five avoid eviction and a single mother of 7 remove the lien on their house by helping her pay down her taxes. Through the initiative of one of our high school parishioners and his family, there are over 400 coats to keep kids warm. These are answer to prayer. So, the next time you are at Mass and we pray the general intercessions, we might pray “Lord, hear our prayer,” but God is praying that we hear the call to be his hands and feet, his voice, his touch in our world. You are the answer to someone’s prayer.

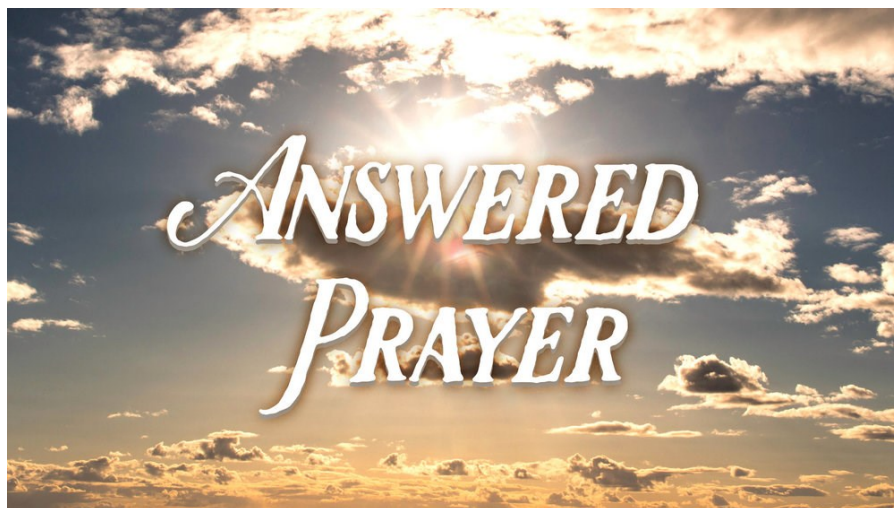
For those among us for whom this Christmas is a hard time due to loss or loneliness, please know you are being held in prayer.

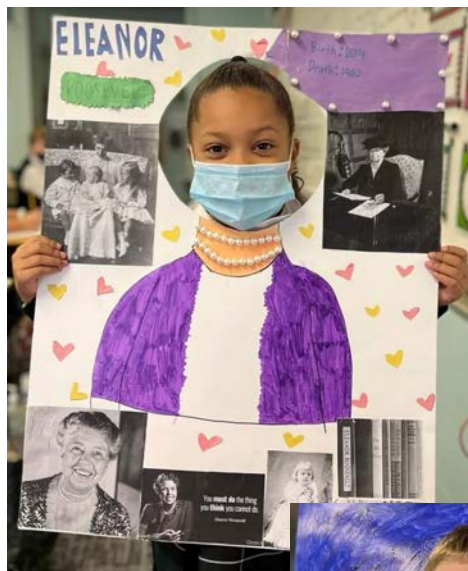
