Reading for January 2, 2021

Matthew 2:1-12

Adults:

In what ways are you called to be like the Magi, courageous and trusting, even when you do not know where you are being led?

We offer this form of *Lectio Divina* (sacred reading) for pondering Scripture and for faith sharing with family members and other people.

- Listen/ Read (*Lectio*): Ponder God's word and listen for what touches your heart.
- Meditate (*Meditatio*): Attend to what you notice. Allow God's word to resonate in you.
- Speak/Share (*Oratio*): Prayerfully share with Jesus or with the group your thoughts and feelings.
- Rest in God's presence (*Contemplatio*): Notice God's presence and be still, surrounded by God's love.
- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God's nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

Teens:

The star guided the Magi to Jesus. What signs in your life have led you to Jesus?

Children:

When do you look for Jesus? Where do you find him?

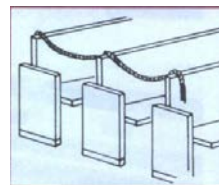

Email/Texting Scam Alert

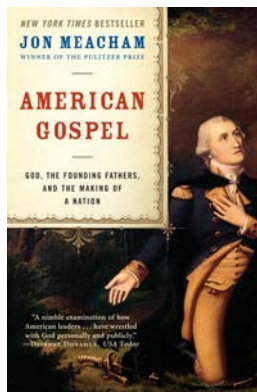

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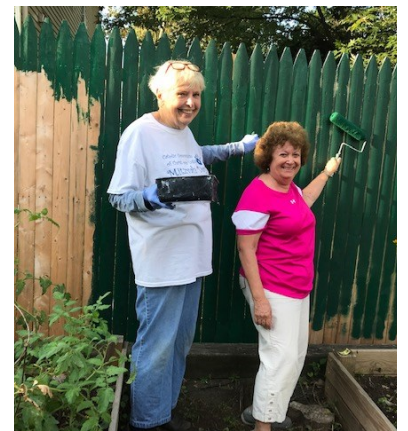

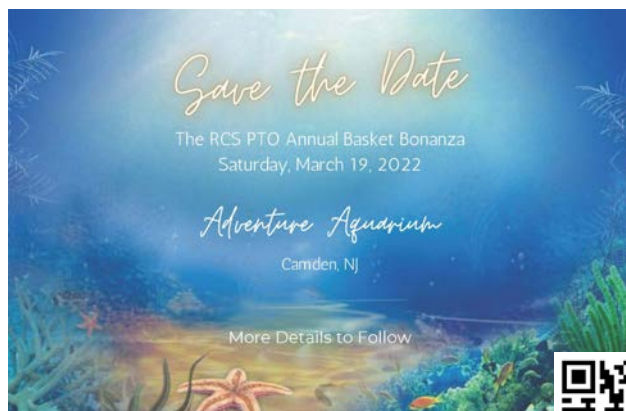
