- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God's nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

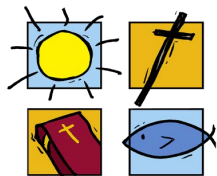

Sunday of the Word of God



The Third Sunday in Ordinary Time is the "Sunday of the Word of God," as declared by Pope Francis in 2019:

I hereby declare that the Third Sunday in Ordinary Time is to be devoted

to the celebration, study and dissemination of the word of God. This Sunday of the Word of God will thus be a fitting part of that time of the year when we are encouraged to strengthen our bonds with the Jewish people and to pray for Christian unity. This is more than a temporal coincidence: the celebration of the Sunday of the Word of God has ecumenical value, since the Scriptures point out, for those who listen, the path to authentic and firm unity. (Pope Francis, [Aperuit Illis](#), 3)

Did you know? In the proclamation of the Word, Christ Jesus, Our Light, is made present in our midst in the Sunday assembly. It is not only in the bread and wine become Body and Blood where Jesus becomes real, but also when the scripture readings for the mass are proclaimed. Pope Francis is inviting Catholics across the world to deepen their appreciation, love and faithful witness to God and his Word. It is a special day devoted to "the celebration, study and dissemination of the Word of God." The Pope encourages us to read and pray with Sacred Scripture, lingering over it so that God's Word can speak to our hearts, and "stimulate believers [each one of us!] to be living instruments of transmission of the Word," and to keep in mind the integral relationship of the Word and the Eucharist.

You'll notice that the ambo (from where Sacred Scripture is proclaimed) is enhanced with flowers and candles this weekend, and the Book of the Gospels is enthroned in front of it. This symbolizes how we are to reverence the Word and carry the Word with us after we have heard it proclaimed at Mass everyday. Take some time this week to read the Bible and reflect on the abundant graces we receive in sharing the Word as a community of faith.

Sexual Abuse Hotline

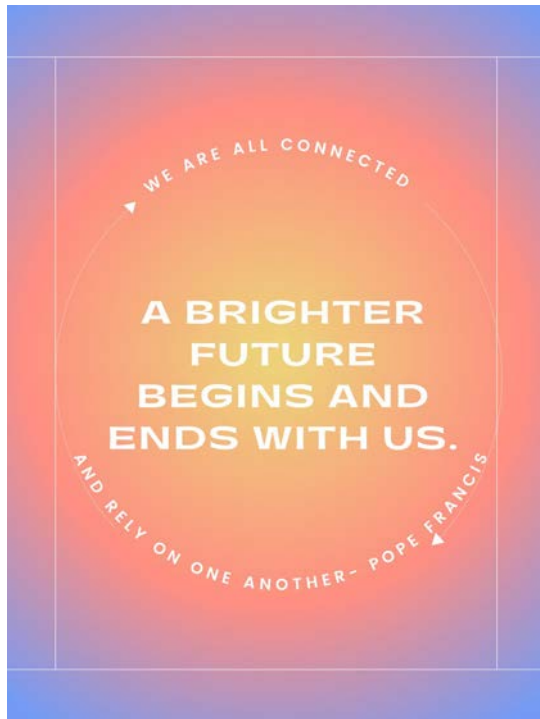


Sexual abuse is a crime that must be reported, investigated and responded to so that victims are protected and those who commit abuse are removed from ministry.

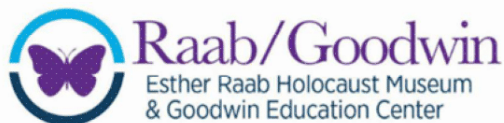

The United Nations General Assembly designated January 27, the anniversary of the liberation of Auschwitz-Birkenau, as International Holocaust Remembrance Day. This year, we will commemorate this day by speaking to Pastor Chris Edmonds, son of Master Sergeant Roddie Edmonds, featured in the film *Footsteps of My Father*, at 7:00pm. Prior to the program, the community will have an opportunity to screen the film from home.

Footsteps of My Father uncovers an act of extraordinary courage by Master Sergeant Roddie Edmonds, a devout Christian from Tennessee who risked his own life to save the lives of 200 Jewish G.I.s when they were prisoners of the Germans in WWII. This act of bravery would have been forgotten and lost to history, had it not been for the rediscovery of Edmonds' private diary by his son. Pastor Chris Edmonds sets out to follow the footsteps of his father, discovering the truth about the brutality inflicted on captured Jewish American G.I.s, and searching for the men, and their families, who he saved.
