Vision 2024



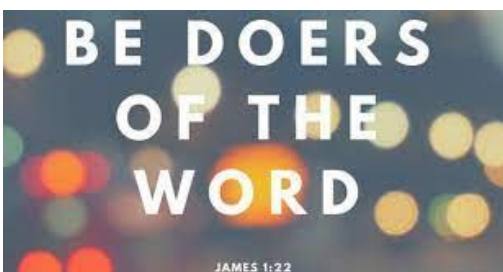
Vision 2024 - Introduction

Encountering God in Our Community

One evening, a catechist was teaching a class of young catechumens about the Church ; how the Church is blessed with diverse people united in one faith. But he noticed that a particular boy was restless and tuned-off. To keep the restless boy busy, he tore a map of the world out of an old magazine, cut it into pieces and invited him to reassemble it in a jigsaw puzzle. And at the back of the map was the face of Jesus. To the catechist' amazement, the boy presented him with the puzzle perfectly solved within few minutes. How did you do it so quickly? He asked. It was easy, the boy replied. I didn't know what the world look like, and I just could not make sense out of the lines and dots. Then, I noticed part of a man's face on the back side of one of the pieces. So, I turned them all over, put the man together and the world was okay. The catechist smiled and in wisdom said to the boy, "This is how God brings together diverse people to become a community of faith. And that transformed his life.

In the first part of this Sunday's gospel, a large crowd came to Jesus; His apostles, people from Judea, Jerusalem and the coastal region of Tyre and Sidon. We should not read this as a simple meeting with Jesus. But we should look deeper. It was a great moment of ENCOUNTER. The Spirit moved them to come from different places to encounter Jesus. The crowd was rich in diversity but united in faith. They have come to receive grace, blessing and to be transformed by the gracious words of Jesus . He gives them hope. In their different life situations, poverty, hunger, mourning and persecution, they now count themselves blessed.

Brethren, our parish is blessed with wonderful people and with tremendous gifts and charisms. Each of us in his or her uniqueness, difference and capabilities has been empowered by the Spirit to encounter God. We are called to see ourselves as one body of Christ, speak and act as one community of faith. Our gifts and capabilities are to be used for the growth of our community. And we have to act with love. Love is the vivifying element that gives every gift its meaning. Your person, presence, and participation make this community what it is - a welcoming community. Remember, EACH OF US ONE OF US.

- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God's nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

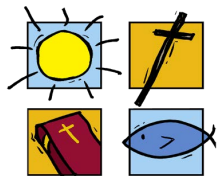

Anna "Madre" Bates - Black History Month



In 1943, Anna "Madre" Bates of Detroit founded Our Lady of Victory, a Catholic mission in her neighborhood in a time and place where white supremacy and segregation were prominent and where Church authorities resisted her advocacy. Her neighborhood was largely Protestant and the nearby white

Catholic parishes would not allow Black Catholics to enter. Despite the many obstacles, she persevered and founded Our Lady of Victory in her community which was still reeling from the worst race riot in Detroit that took place just two years earlier. Mother Bates took a stand against racial injustice and was an inspiring leader and minister in the Church.

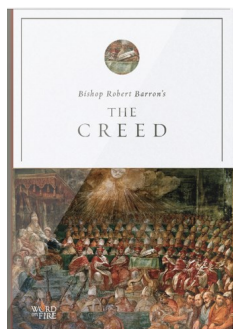
Steering Committee Needed
