We offer this form of *Lectio Divina* (sacred reading) for pondering Scripture and for faith sharing with family members and other people.

- Listen/ Read (*Lectio*): Ponder God's word and listen for what touches your heart.
- Meditate (*Meditatio*): Attend to what you notice. Allow God's word to resonate in you.
- Speak/Share (*Oratio*): Prayerfully share with Jesus or with the group your thoughts and feelings.
- Rest in God's presence (*Contemplatio*): Notice God's presence and be still, surrounded by God's love.
- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God's nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

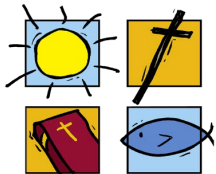
Teens:

For the measure with which you measure will in return be measured out to you...

It was over 120 gallons of fine wine. At the wedding in Cana, as a family faced public humiliation for running out of wine during their wedding celebration, Jesus gives them over 120 gallons of wine which tasted better than the wine previously served. He gave them more than enough and he gave them his best. His measure was overflowing. This is the measure with which we are to measure. This is the metric for our Vision 2024...we offer love, forgiveness, healing, our time, and our gifts generously...especially to those most in need.

For as disciples of Jesus, we are called to be Jesus to others. His ministry is our ministry. His measure is to be our measure. We need to be personally invested.

This is how we actualize Vision 2024. Under Vital Structures of the Vision, we commit to a "culture of ownership, co-responsibility and discernment." Jesus formed his community around a table - Eucharist - it is a communal relationship...with Him and with each other. From this communal experience, we are strengthened, transformed, and sent out into the world. Each of us is essential because we are unique in what we offer.

Our Scriptures this week invite us to reflect on our engagement in the ministry of Jesus. We are called to discern how we can be more actively involved in our parish community.

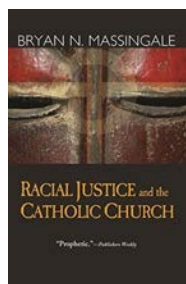
Steering Committee Needed
