Luke 6: 39-45

Adults:

We offer this form of *Lectio Divina* (sacred reading) for pondering Scripture and for faith sharing with family members and other people.

- Listen/ Read (*Lectio*): Ponder God’s word and listen for what touches your heart.
- Meditate (*Meditatio*): Attend to what you notice. Allow God’s word to resonate in you.
- Speak/Share (*Oratio*): Prayerfully share with Jesus or with the group your thoughts and feelings.
- Rest in God’s presence (*Contemplatio*): Notice God’s presence and be still, surrounded by God’s love.
- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God’s nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

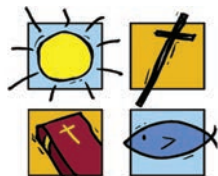

Weekly Reflection



A good person out of the store of goodness in his heart produces good...

During this last week before we begin Lent Jesus reminds us what it means to be a good disciple. He uses some very clear examples to teach us that we have to look inward first before we can help to lead and heal others. The building up of our own character, and our own spirituality, will guide us in right actions and right relationships. But we cannot do it alone. We need to seek Christ in our daily lives. To emulate him in our words and actions. If we actively look for ways to be “Christ-like” we store up the goodness in our hearts and we can naturally produce good.

Mother Mary Lange - Black History Month



Born Elizabeth Clarisse Lange, Mother Mary Lange founded the first community for Black women religious in the United States. Of French and African descent, she and her mother immigrated from the Caribbean to the United States in the early 1800s. Her order, the Oblate Sisters of Providence, provided teachers for the Black Catholic school they founded in Baltimore called Saint Frances Academy. Mother Mary Lange, her religious order, and her school overcame opposition and violent attacks from anti-immigration, anti-Catholic, racist, and xenophobic groups. Saint Frances Academy still operates today and Mother Mary's service is a shining example of Black leadership in Catholic education.
