



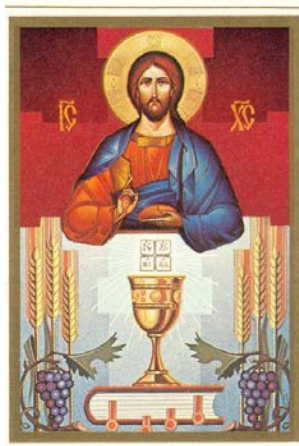

FAITH FORMATION REGISTRATION FOR 2022 – 2023

The Elementary Faith Formation office is accepting registrations for students grades Pre-K through 8 for the catechetical year beginning September 2022. Families whose children currently attend classes at COL have received re registration information via email with completed forms and fees due by June 1, 2022. Families new to elementary Faith Formation (Pre-k – 6th) or Youth Faith Formation (7th & 8th) can access registration forms from the parish website, or register students and pay online. NOTE: Children must attend Elementary Faith Formation class for one year prior to preparing to celebrate 1st Reconciliation and 1st Eucharist. Families are encouraged to begin their child's faith formation in first grade.

Reading for June 19, 2022

Luke 9: 11b-17

Adults:

What has the gift of the Eucharist meant to you? Or how has God satisfied a hunger in your heart?

We offer this form of *Lectio Divina* (sacred reading) for pondering Scripture and for faith sharing with family members and other people.

- Listen/ Read (*Lectio*): Ponder God's word and listen for what touches your heart.
- Meditate (*Meditatio*): Attend to what you notice. Allow God's word to resonate in you.
- Speak/Share (*Oratio*): Prayerfully share with Jesus or with the group your thoughts and feelings.
- Rest in God's presence (*Contemplatio*): Notice God's presence and be still, surrounded by God's love.
- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God's nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

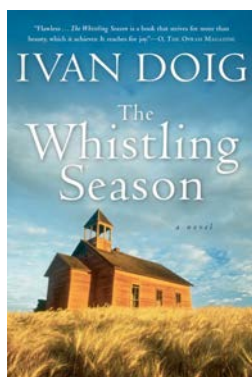

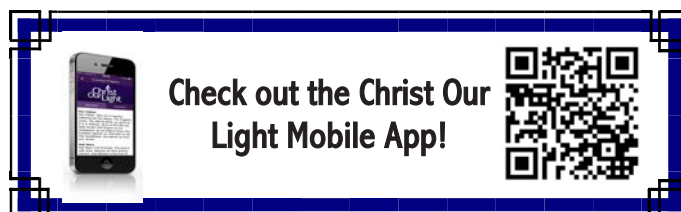
