FAITH FORMATION REGISTRATION FOR 2022 – 2023

We offer this form of *Lectio Divina* (sacred reading) for pondering Scripture and for faith sharing with family members and other people.

- Listen/ Read (*Lectio*): Ponder God's word and listen for what touches your heart.
- Meditate (*Meditatio*): Attend to what you notice. Allow God's word to resonate in you.
- Speak/Share (*Oratio*): Prayerfully share with Jesus or with the group your thoughts and feelings.
- Rest in God's presence (*Contemplatio*): Notice God's presence and be still, surrounded by God's love.
- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God's nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

When do you make time to sit with God and listen to the Spirit working within you?

Children:

In the past week, when have you prayed and when have you done good things for others? When could you have done better?

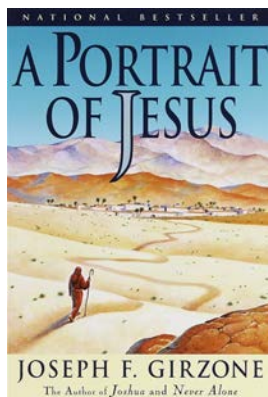

Our trip to BuBe's Brewery in Mt. Joy, PA was a Murder Mystery enjoyed by all. Requests to do it again next year.

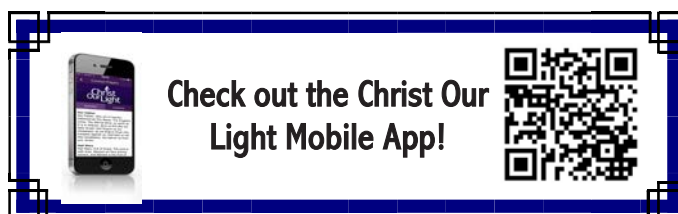

Next Mission July 2023

To my friends from the Mustard Seed Communities-

I thought I knew what it would be like to see each resident. I thought I was prepared for what I would see, hear, touch, smell, and taste.

Now I know one cannot prepare to meet People who walk so closely with the Lord.

When I met the residents at Sophie's Place for the first time I was greatly humbled. My ego with all that I thought I knew disappeared. The present moment surrounded me. Present in holding the little hand, of seeing a beautiful smile, of hearing laughs of true authentic joy, of feeling all the love shared within the communities.

The residents and Aunties in the Mustard Seed communities are teachers of the soul. One of the greatest teachings I learned from the residents was self acceptance as well as non judgement of others. The residents have a gift of embracing their true authentic selves. It was inspirational to watch them literally dancing like no one was watching during circle time. I remember watching as residents at Jacobs Latter pulled anyone that would join them onto the dance floor. It didn't matter what size, shape, ethnicity, race, ability, or disability, the residents didn't see a difference. We are all one created by God.

One of the greatest lessons I learned from the Aunties is written in the Mustard Seed Community Mission statement "We are committed to the fostering of homes and communities, which will lead us all to loving service and mutual respect and which will bring us joy, hope and dignity," (Mission Statement). The respect and dignity that each Auntie has for all of the residents is inspirational. One of my favorite memories is hearing one of the Aunties sing Jesus Loves Me to the residents at night before they went to sleep. I also enjoyed participating each morning in helping the aunties wheel all the residents from Sophies Place to the Chapel for daily prayer service. This was so special because it gave the residents the chance to pray as a group each day. Msgr. Gregory, the founder of the first Mustard Seed Community, told the mission team that the Mustard Seed Communities give the residents the opportunity to know God. Before the individuals became apart of the Mustard Seed Communities they were not given the opportunity to know God. They were not given the dignity or respect that they deserved. The Mustard Seed Communities gives the most love and dignity and respect I have ever witnessed before.

Mustard Seed Communities is a example to all of how to live our life.

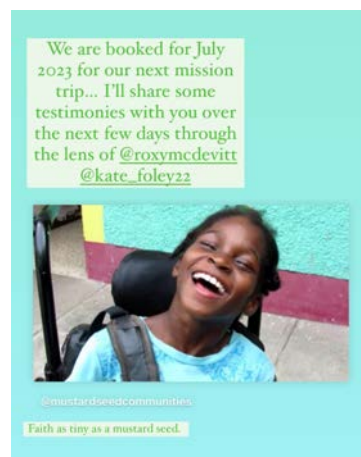

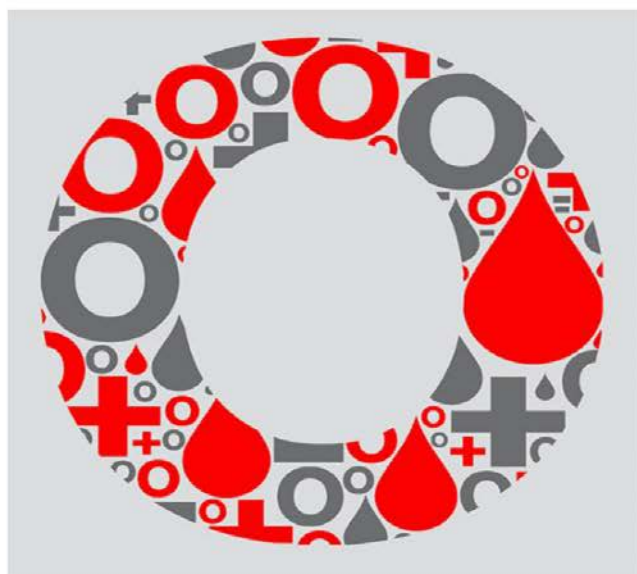

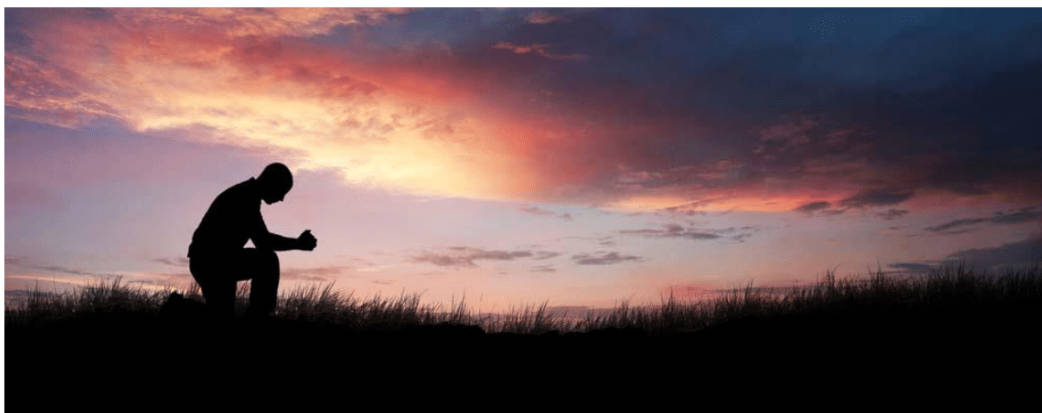
